\bigcirc	The economically active population marked 27,649 thousand in February, which grew 300 thousand persons or 1.1 percent year-on-year.									
\bigcirc	The labor force participation rate stood at 62.3 percent in February, up 0.3%p year-on-year.									
< E	Employed persons and employment-population ratio >									
\bigcirc	The number of employed persons totaled 26,346 thousand persons in February, which went up 263 thousand persons or 1.0 percent year-on-year.									
\bigcirc	The employment-population ratio recorded 59.4 percent in February, up 0.2%p year-on-year.									
< l	Jnemployed persons and unemployment rate >									
\bigcirc	The number of unemployed persons totaled 1,303 thousand people in February, which increased 38 thousand persons or 3.0 percent year-on-year.									
\bigcirc	The unemployment rate marked 4.7 percent in February, up 0.1%p year-on-year.

O The economically inactive population totaled 16,734 thousand people in February, decreasing 11 thousand persons or 0.1 percent year-on-year.
