



# Cultivated Area of Autumn Cabbages and Radishes in 2022

- ☐ The cultivated area of autumn cabbages increased by 4.6% from 13,345ha in 2021 to 13,953ha in 2022.
  - O The cultivated area of autumn cabbages recorded a year-on-year increase owing to the rise in cabbage prices during the July-September period.
  - □ The cultivated area of autumn radishes grew by 7.1% from 5,919ha in 2021 to 6,340ha in 2022.
  - O The cultivated area of autumn radishes recorded a year-on-year increase owing to the rise in radish prices during the July-September period.



### 1. Cultivated area of autumn cabbages

The cultivated area of autumn cabbages grew by 608ha (4.6%) from 13,345ha in 2021 to 13,953ha in 2022.

- The cultivated area of autumn cabbages recorded a year-on-year increase owing to the rise in cabbage prices during the July-September period.
- Cabbage prices between July and September (Source: Korea Agricultural Marketing Information Service, wholesale prices of high-quality cabbages per kg)
  - \* 1,033 won in 2019  $\rightarrow$  1,910 won in 2020  $\rightarrow$  1,040 won in 2021  $\rightarrow$  2,298 won in 2022

< Cultivated area and price of autumn cabbages >





As for the cultivated area of autumn cabbages by region, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure of 3,289ha, which was followed by Chungbuk (2,181ha), Gyeongbuk (2,143ha), Gangwon (1,588ha) and Jeonbuk (1,413ha).



#### 2. Cultivated area of autumn radishes

The cultivated area of autumn radishes rose by 422ha (7.1%) from 5,919ha in 2021 to 6,340ha in 2022.

- The cultivated area of autumn radishes recorded a year-on-year increase owing to the rise in radish prices during the July-September period.
- Radish prices between July and September (Source: Korea Agricultural Marketing Information Service, wholesale prices of high-quality radishes per kg)
  - \* 530 won in 2019  $\rightarrow$  967 won in 2020  $\rightarrow$  620 won in 2021  $\rightarrow$  1,311 won in 2022

#### < Cultivated area and price of autumn radishes >





As for the cultivated area of autumn radishes by region, Gyeonggi recorded the highest figure of 1,244ha, which was followed by Chungnam (1,164ha), Jeonbuk (1,099ha), Jeonnam (1,071ha) and Gangwon (535ha).
