

Rice Production in 2021

- ☐ The rice production recorded 3.882 million tons in 2021, which grew by 10.7% from 3.507 million tons in 2020.
- O Cultivated area: 726,432ha in $2020 \rightarrow 732,477$ ha in 2021 (a rise of 0.8%)
- O Rice production per 10a (when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 92.9%): 483kg in $2020 \rightarrow 530$ kg in 2021 (a rise of 9.8%)
 - * When applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 470kg in 2020 → 516kg in 2021

Compared to the previous year, the rice production per 10a showed an increase owing to a rise in sunshine hours and a drop in precipitation during the July-August period, and favorable weather conditions during the September-October period.

- O Rice production (when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 92.9%): 3.507 million tons in $2020 \rightarrow 3.882$ million tons in 2021 (a rise of 10.7%)
 - * When applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 3.412 million tons in 2020 → 3.777 million tons in 2021

1. Rice Production of the Nation

- ☐ The rice production recorded 3.882 million tons in 2021, rising by 10.7% from 3.507 million tons in 2020.
- O Total rice production: 3.507 million tons in 2020 \rightarrow 3.882 million tons in 2021
- * Rice production when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 3.412 million tons in 2020 → 3.777 million tons in 2021
- O The total rice production rose by 375 thousand tons (10.7%) from the previous year due to the increase in the cultivated area (0.8%) and the rice production per 10a (9.8%).

- ☐ The cultivated area of rice totaled 732,477 hectares in 2021, which increased by 0.8% from 726,432 hectares in 2020.
- O The cultivated area of rice recorded a year-on-year increase owing to the rising trend in rice price and the end of the government project to encourage farmers to cultivate other crops instead of rice.
- * Rice price (Korea Agricultural Marketing Information Service, high quality of rice, annual average wholesale price of 20kg)

- □ The rice production per 10a marked 530kg in 2021, rising by 9.8% from 483kg in 2020.
- O Rice production per 10a: 483kg in 2020 → 530kg in 2021
 - \divideontimes Rice production per 10a when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 470kg in 2020 \rightarrow 516kg in 2021

2. Rice Production by Province


As for rice production by province, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure at 790 thousand tons, which was followed by Chungnam (773 thousand tons) and Jeonbuk (594 thousand tons).
