


Estimated Rice Production in 2022




1. Estimated Rice Production of the Nation

- □ The rice production is estimated to record 3.804 million tons in 2022, falling by 2.0% from 3.882 million tons in 2021.
 - O Total rice production (the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 92.9%): 3.882 million tons in 2021 \rightarrow 3.804 million tons in 2022 (2.0% \downarrow)
 - * Estimated rice production when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 3.777 million tons in 2021 \rightarrow 3.702 million tons in 2022
 - O The total rice production is estimated to fall by 78 thousand tons (-2.0%) from the previous year due to the decrease in the cultivated area (-0.7%) and the rice production per 10a (-1.3%).

< Trend in the cultivated area and production of rice by year >

\Box The cultivated area of rice totaled 727,158ha in 2022, which declined by 0.7% from 732,477ha in 2021.

O The cultivated area of rice showed a slight decrease owing to the government project to encourage farmers to cultivate other crops and the drop in rice prices.

- \Box The rice production per 10a is estimated to record 523kg in 2022, falling by 1.3% from 530kg in 2021.
 - O Rice production per 10a: 530kg in 2021 \rightarrow 523kg in 2022 (1.3%))
 - * Rice production per 10a when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 516kg in 2021 \rightarrow 509kg in 2022
 - O The number of ears per root recorded a drop owing to a lack in precipitation between the first ten days of June and the first ten days of July.
 - Number of ears per m²: 22.5 ears in 2021 \rightarrow 20.9 ears in 2022 (1.6 ears \downarrow)
 - * Weather from the first ten days of June to the first ten days of July (Korea Meteorological Administration)
 - · Precipitation (mm): 229.6mm in 2020 \rightarrow 293.3mm in 2021 \rightarrow 195.9mm in 2022 (33.2% \downarrow)
 - O The number of whole grains showed a decrease owing to a lack in sunshine hours and precipitation between July and August.
 - Number of whole grains per m²: 30,725 whole grains in 2021 \rightarrow 29,417 whole grains in 2022 (1,308 whole grains \downarrow)
 - * Weather from the first ten days of July to the first ten days of August (Korea Meteorological Administration)
 - \cdot Sunshine hours: 134.5 hours in 2020 \rightarrow 295.2 hours in 2021 \rightarrow 221.0 hours in 2022 (25.1% \downarrow)
 - * Weather from the middle ten days of August to the last ten days of August (Korea Meteorological Administration)
 - · Precipitation (mm): 123.7mm in 2020 \rightarrow 220.1mm in 2021 \rightarrow 175.1mm in 2022 (20.4% \downarrow)


2. Estimated Rice Production by Province

As for rice production by province, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure at 740 thousand tons, which was followed by Chungnam (735 thousand tons) and Jeonbuk (619 thousand tons).
