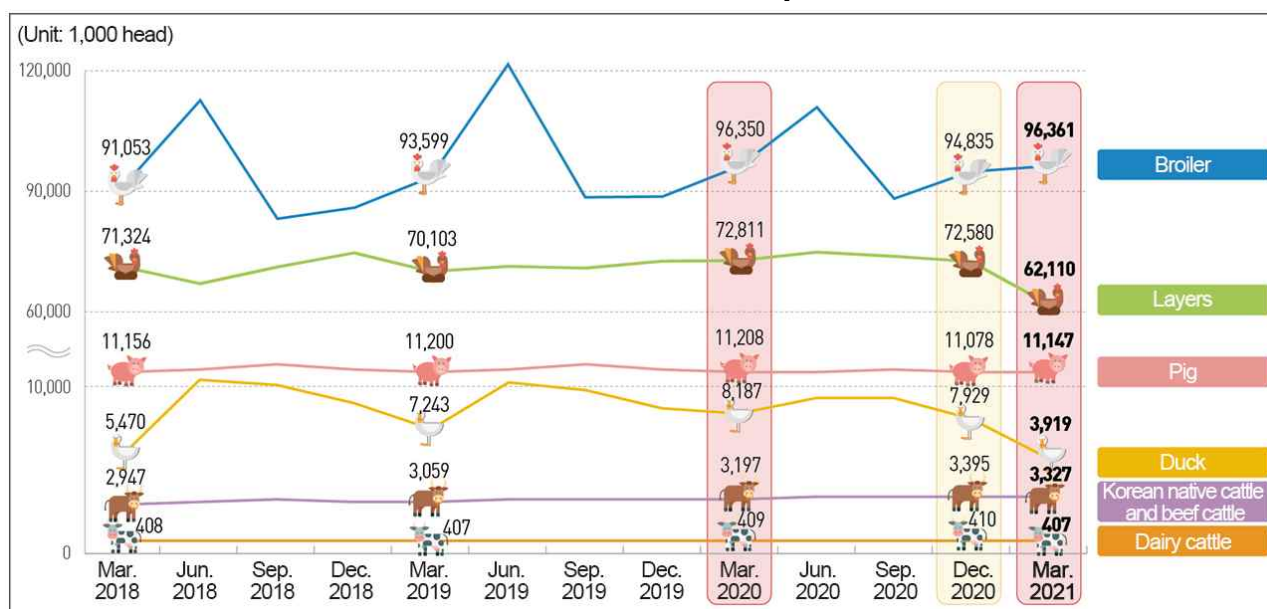




# Livestock Statistics in the First Quarter of 2021

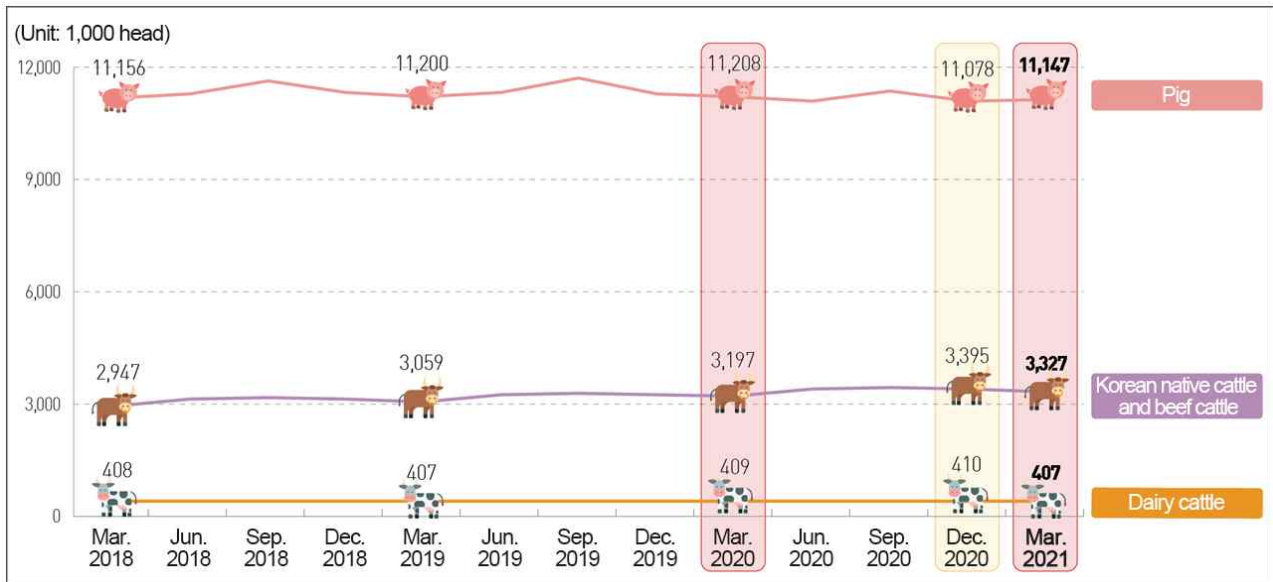
- In the first quarter of 2021, the number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle' and broilers recorded an increase. Whereas, the number of dairy cattle, pigs, layers and ducks recorded a decrease compared to the first quarter of 2020.

## < Livestock statistics in the first quarter of 2021 >



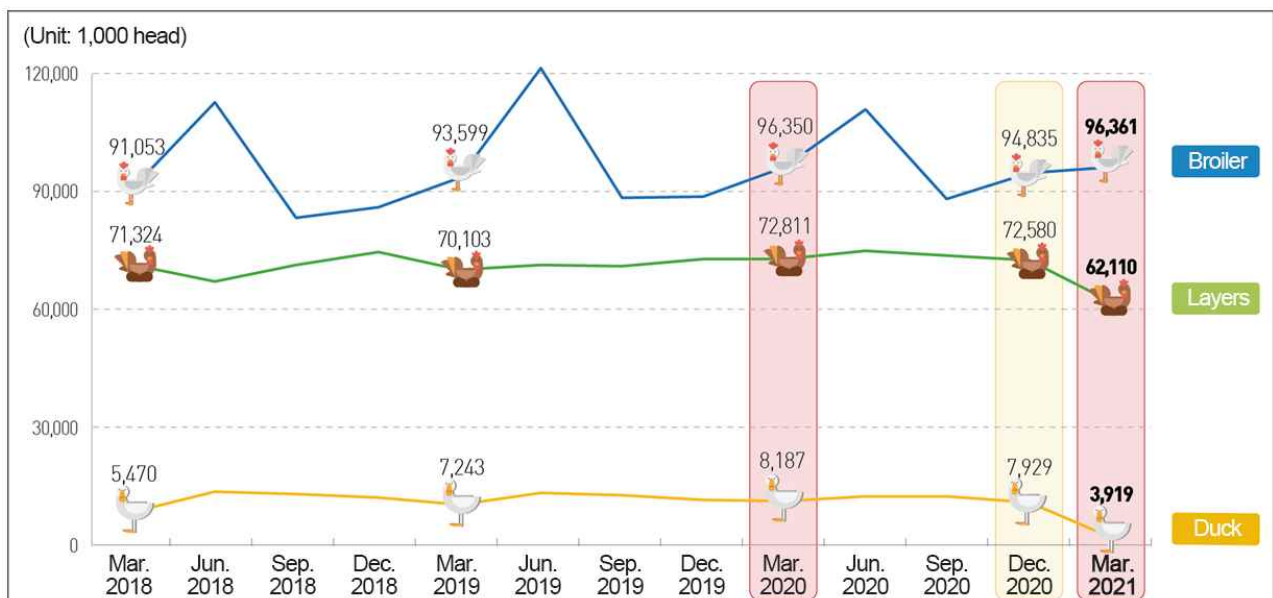
- The number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle' amounted to 3.327 million in the first quarter of 2021. This figure rose by 129 thousand (4.0%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but fell by 68 thousand (-2.0%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of dairy cattle totaled 407 thousand in the first quarter of 2021. This figure dropped by 3 thousand (-0.6%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 3 thousand (-0.8%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of pigs was 11.147 million in the first quarter of 2021. This figure declined by 62 thousand (-0.5%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but grew by 69 thousand (0.6%) from the previous quarter.

- ☐ The number of layers amounted to 62.11 million in the first quarter of 2021. This figure declined by 10.701 million (-14.7%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 10.469 million (-14.4%) from the previous quarter.
- ☐ The number of broilers totaled 96.361 million in the first quarter of 2021. This figure grew by 12 thousand (0.0%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 1.527 million (1.6%) from the previous quarter.
- ☐ The number of ducks totaled 3.919 million in the first quarter of 2021. This figure fell by 4.269 million (-52.1%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 4.01 million (-50.6%) from the previous quarter.
