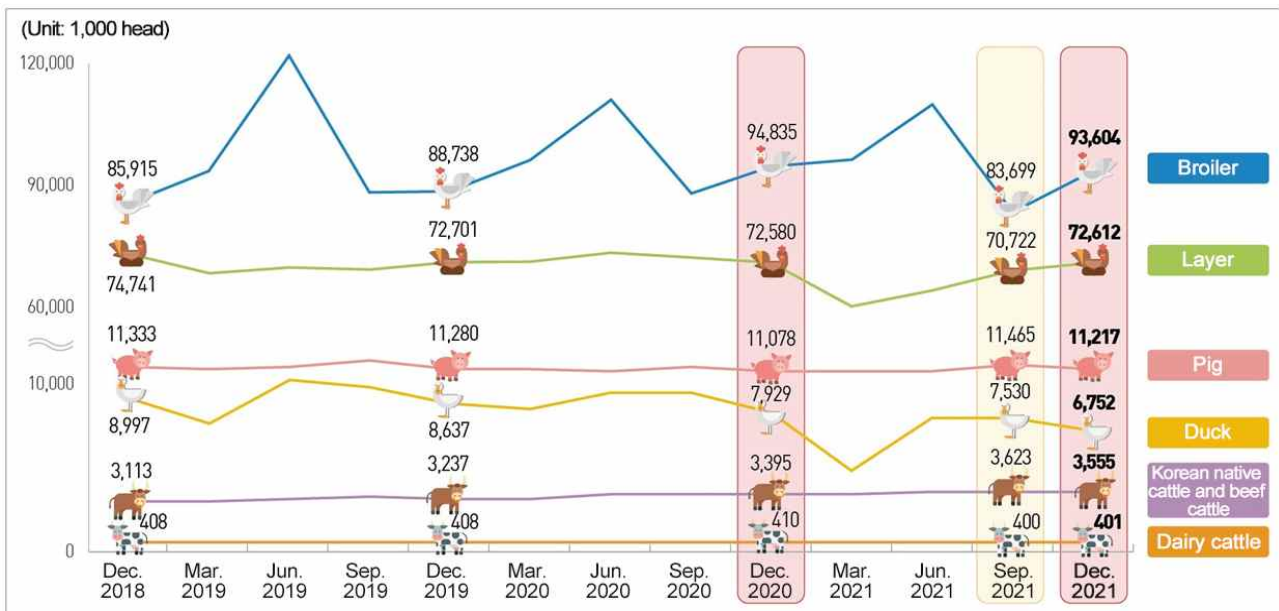




Livestock Statistics in the Fourth Quarter of 2021

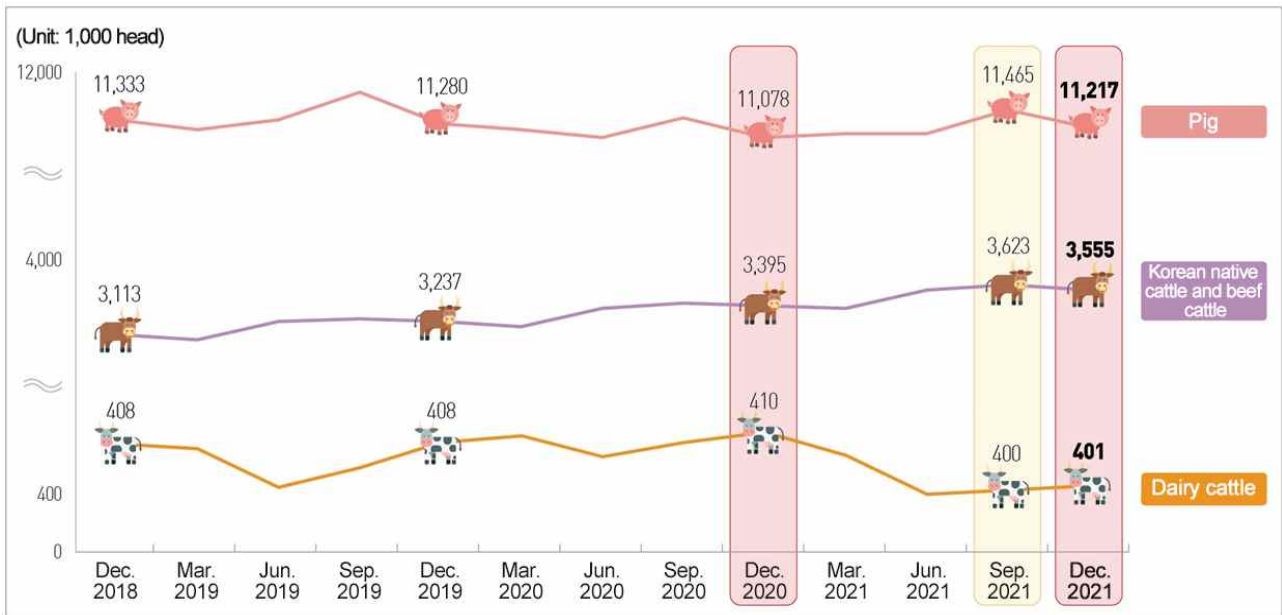
- In the fourth quarter of 2021, the number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle', pigs and layers marked a year-on-year increase. Whereas, the number of dairy cattle, broilers and ducks marked a year-on-year decrease.

< Livestock statistics in the fourth quarter of 2021 >



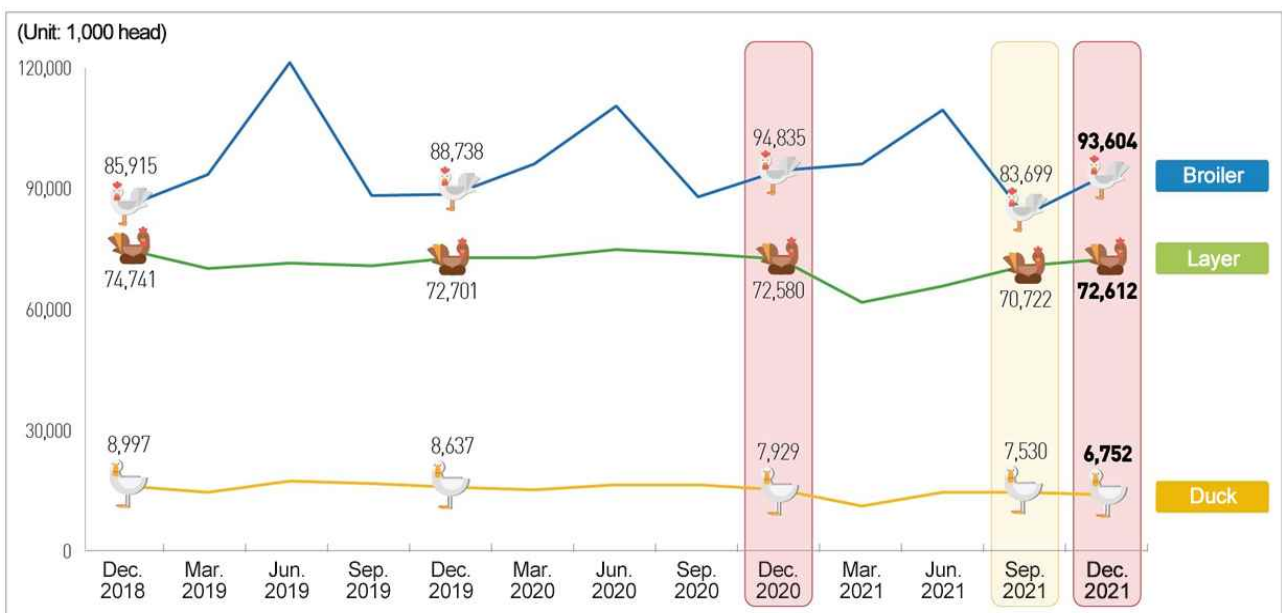
- The number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle' amounted to 3.555 million in the fourth quarter of 2021. This figure rose by 160 thousand (4.7%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but dropped by 68 thousand (-1.9%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of dairy cattle totaled 401 thousand in the fourth quarter of 2021. This figure dropped by 8 thousand (-2.0%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but rose by 2 thousand (0.4%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of pigs was 11.217 million in the fourth quarter of 2021. This figure grew by 139 thousand (1.3%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but fell by 248 thousand (-2.2%) from the previous quarter.

- The number of layers amounted to 72.612 million in the fourth quarter of 2021. This figure grew by 33 thousand (0.0%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 1.89 million (2.7%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of broilers totaled 93.604 million in the fourth quarter of 2021. This figure fell by 1.231 million (-1.3%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but grew by 9.904 million (11.8%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of ducks totaled 6.752 million in the fourth quarter of 2021. This figure fell by 1.177 million (-14.8%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 778 thousand (-10.3%) from the previous quarter.
