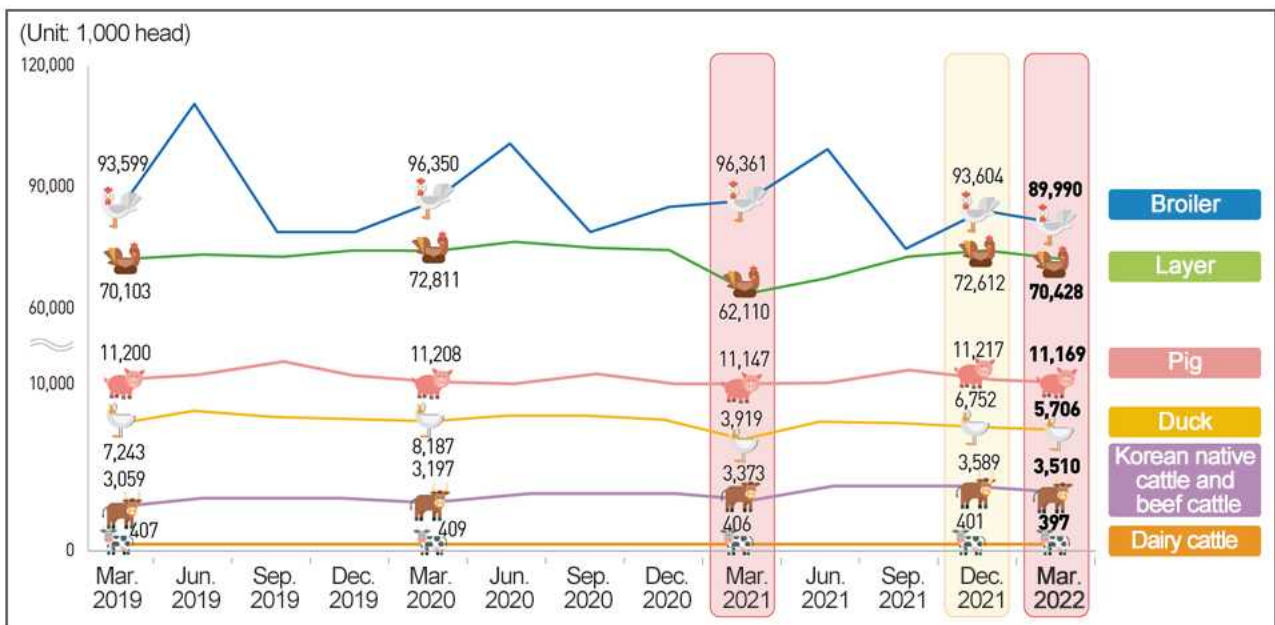




# Livestock Statistics in the First Quarter of 2022

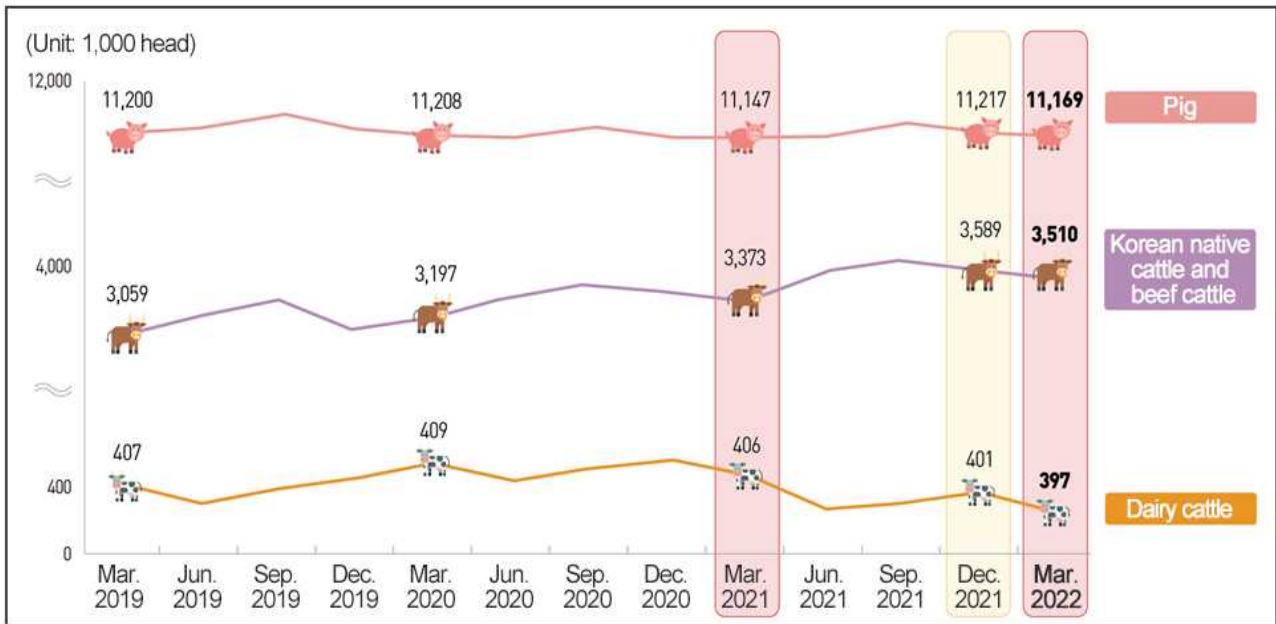
- In the first quarter of 2022, the number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle', pigs, layers and ducks recorded a year-on-year increase. Whereas, the number of dairy cattle and broilers recorded a year-on-year decrease.

< Livestock statistics in the first quarter of 2022 >



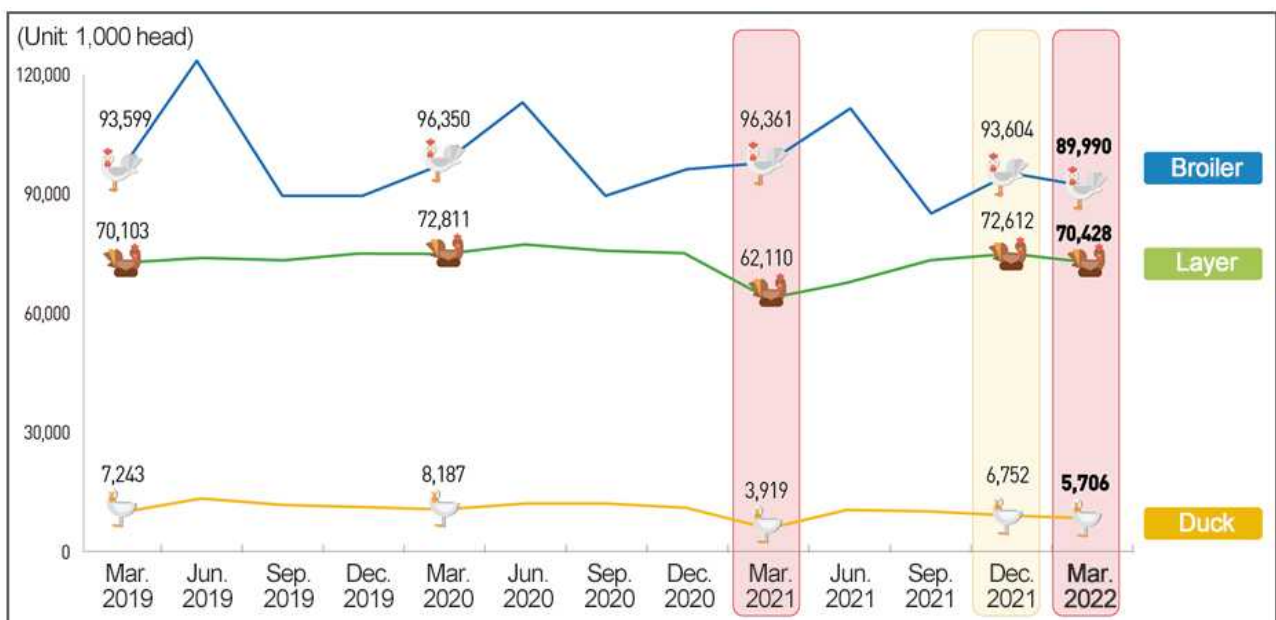
- The number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle' amounted to 3.51 million in the first quarter of 2022. This figure rose by 137 thousand (4.1%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but dropped by 79 thousand (-2.2%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of dairy cattle totaled 397 thousand in the first quarter of 2022. This figure fell by 9 thousand (-2.1%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 3 thousand (-0.9%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of pigs was 11.169 million in the first quarter of 2022. This figure grew by 22 thousand (0.2%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but fell by 47 thousand (-0.4%) from the previous quarter.

- The number of layers amounted to 70.428 million in the first quarter of 2022. This figure rose by 8.318 million (13.4%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but declined by 2.184 million (-3.0%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of broilers totaled 89.99 million in the first quarter of 2022. This figure fell by 6.371 million (-6.6%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 3.613 million (-3.9%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of ducks totaled 5.706 million in the first quarter of 2022. This figure grew by 1.788 million (45.6%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but dropped by 1.046 million (-15.5%) from the previous quarter.
