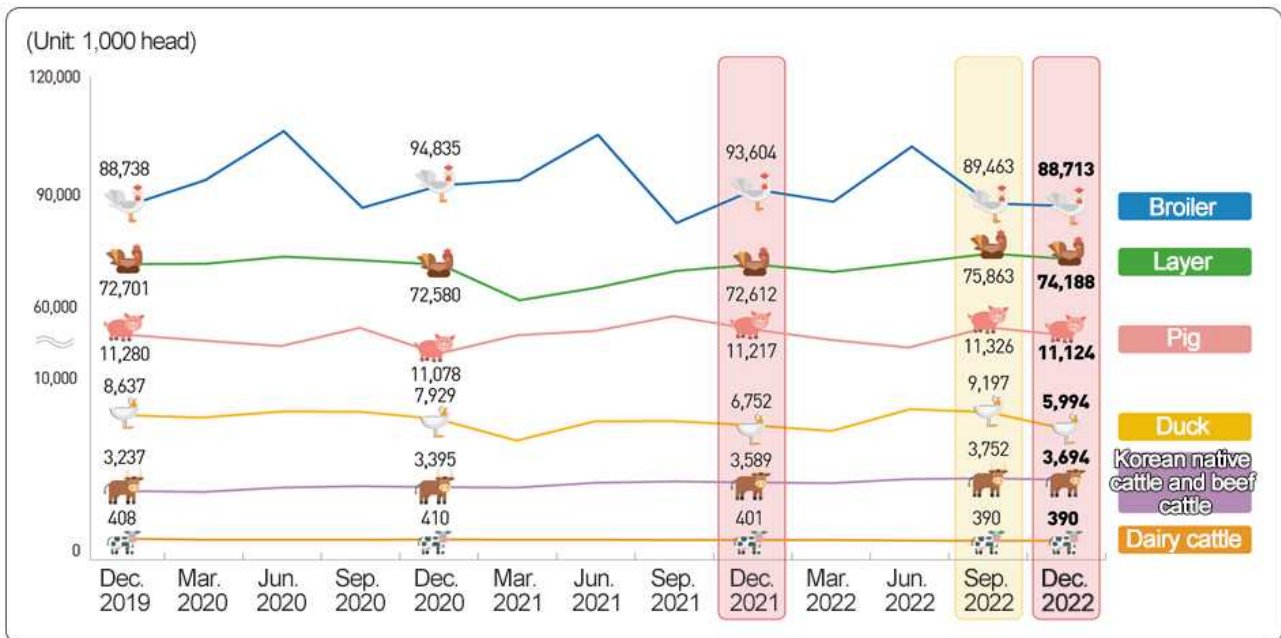




# Livestock Statistics in the Fourth Quarter of 2022

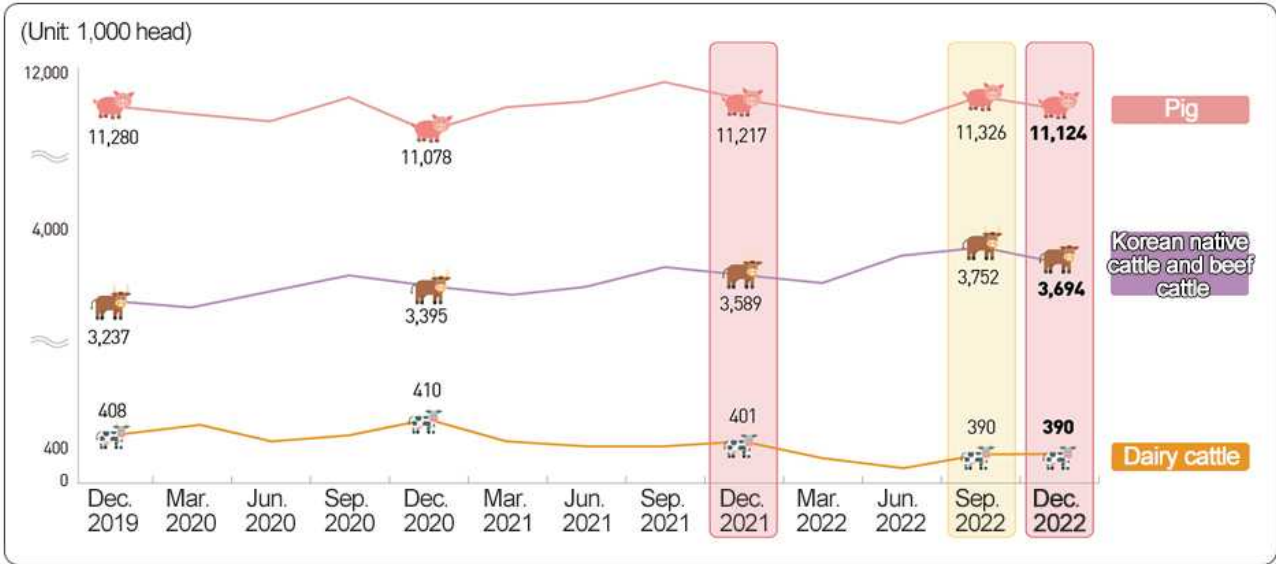
- In the fourth quarter of 2022, the number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle' and layers recorded a year-on-year increase. Whereas, the number of dairy cattle, pigs, broilers and ducks recorded a year-on-year decrease.

## < Livestock statistics in the fourth quarter of 2022 >



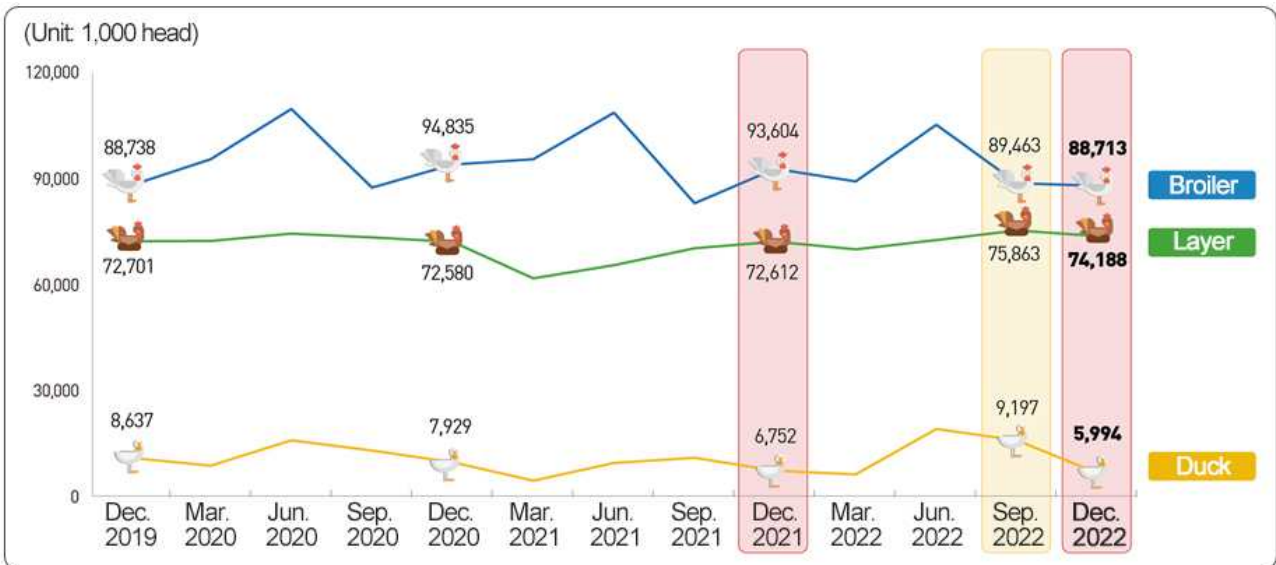
- The number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle' amounted to 3.694 million in the fourth quarter of 2022. This figure rose by 104 thousand (2.9%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but dropped by 59 thousand (-1.6%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of dairy cattle totaled 390 thousand in the fourth quarter of 2022. This figure fell by 11 thousand (-2.7%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but grew by 0.3 thousand (0.1%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of pigs was 11.124 million in the fourth quarter of 2022. This figure declined by 93 thousand (-0.8%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 202 thousand (-0.8%) from the previous quarter.

**< Trends in the number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle', dairy cattle and pigs >**



- The number of layers amounted to 74.188 million in the fourth quarter of 2022. This figure rose by 1.576 million (2.2%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but fell by 1.675 million (-2.2%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of broilers totaled 88.713 million in the fourth quarter of 2022. This figure fell by 4.89 million (-5.2%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 750 thousand (-0.8%) from the previous quarter.
- The number of ducks totaled 5.994 million in the fourth quarter of 2022. This figure dropped by 758 thousand (-11.2%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 3.202 million (-34.8%) from the previous quarter.
