Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index in the Fourth Quarter



In the fourth quater of 2021, the Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index rose by 3.9% from the fourth quater of 2020, due to the increase in imported goods in spite of the decrease in domestic goods.

O (Domestic and imported goods)

Compared to the fourth quarter of 2020, the supply of domestic goods fell by 0.5%, while that of imported goods grew by 15.3%.

○ (By type of goods)

Compared to the fourth quater of 2020, final goods rose by 4.5%. (Among final goods, consumer goods and capital goods grew by 4.5% and 4.4%, respectively.) Intermediate goods grew by 3.5%.

- Consumer goods including 'Mobile phones' and 'Pharmaceuticals, medicinal chemical and botanical products' recorded a year-on-year increase.
- Capital goods including 'Wafer processing equipment' and 'Semiconductor inspection equipment' recorded a year-on-year increase.
- Intermediate goods including 'System semiconductor' and 'Naphtha' recorded a year-on-year increase.


○ (By industry)

Compared to the fourth quater of 2020, 'Fabricated metal products' declined by 10.7%. In the meantime, 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' and 'Machinery and equipment' grew by 12.5% and 7.6%, respectively.

2 (Share of imported goods)

In the fourth quater of 2021, imported goods accounted for 30.0% of the total manufacturing domestic supply, up 3.3%p from the fourth quater of 2020.

○ (Final goods)

Final goods took up 33.0%, up 2.7%p from the fourth quater of 2020.

- (Consumer goods)


 Consumer goods occupied 30.0%, up 2.4%p from the fourth quater of 2020.
- (Capital goods)
 Capital goods accounted for 37.5%, up 3.4%p from the fourth quater of 2020.


O (Intermediate goods)

Intermediate goods took up 28.1%, up 3.9%p from the fourth quater of 2020.

Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index in 2021

1. Manufacturing domestic supply index

- ☐ In 2021, the Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index went up by 4.5% from 2020, due to the increase in domestic and imported goods.
 - Compared to 2020, the supply of domestic goods rose by 0.7% owing to the increase in 'Machinery and equipment' and 'Chemicals and chemical products'. The supply of imported goods rose by 14.7% owing to the increase in 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' and 'Machinery and equipment'.

\square (By type of goods)

Compared to 2020, final goods rose by 2.9%, owing to the increase in imported goods (16.0%) despite the decrease in domestic goods (-2.3%). Intermediate goods grew by 5.6%, owing to the increase in domestic goods (2.8%) and imported goods (13.8%).

- Oconsumer goods grew by 2.5% from 2020, owing to the increase in imported goods (12.6%) despite the decrease in domestic goods (-1.0%).
- Capital goods rose by 3.7% from 2020, owing to the increase in imported goods (20.1%) despite the decrease in domestic goods (-4.4%).

☐ (By industry)

Compared to 2020, 'Other transport equipment' showed a decrease in domestic supply. Whereas, 'Machinery and equipment' and 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' showed an increase in domestic supply.

O (Machinery and equipment)

The supply of 'Machinery and equipment' grew by 12.3% owing to the rise in domestic goods (7.2%) and imported goods (23.4%).

O (Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment)

The supply of 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' grew by 8.9% owing to a rise in imported goods (17.1%) despite a drop in domestic goods (-3.3%).

○ (Other transport equipment)

The supply of 'Other transport equipment' declined by 32.8% owing to a drop in domestic goods (-39.6%) despite a rise in imported goods (3.2%).

2. Share of imported goods

☐ In 2021, imported goods accounted for 29.4% of the total manufacturing domestic supply, up 2.2%p from 2020.

○ (By type of goods)

Final goods took up 32.7%, up 3.2%p from 2020. Intermediate goods took up 27.3%, up 1.8%p from 2020.

- Consumer goods occupied 28.7%, up 2.3%p from 2020. Capital goods accounted for 38.5%, up 4.4%p from 2020.

O (By industry)

Compared to 2020, 'Other transport equipment', 'Pharmaceuticals, medicinal chemical and botanical products' and 'Other manufacturing' recorded an increase in the share of imported goods. Whereas, 'Medical, precision and optical instruments, watches and clocks' recorded a decrease in the share of imported goods.

- (Increase in the share of imported goods)
 'Other transport equipment' (8.4%p), 'Pharmaceuticals, medicinal chemical and botanical products' (5.9%p), 'Other manufacturing' (5.8%p), etc.
- (Decrease in the share of imported goods)
 'Medical, precision and optical instruments, watches and clocks' (-0.8%p)
