



Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index in the Second Quarter of 2022

1 (Domestic supply trend)

In the second quarter of 2022, the Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index rose by 1.5% from the second quarter of 2021, due to the increase in imported goods in spite of the decrease in domestic goods.

○ (Domestic and imported goods)

Compared to the second quarter of 2021, the supply of domestic goods fell by 1.4%, while that of imported goods grew by 8.6%.

○ (By type of goods)

Compared to the second quarter of 2021, final goods dropped by 1.1%. (Among final goods, consumer goods and capital goods fell by 0.4% and 2.2%, respectively.) Intermediate goods grew by 3.4%.

- Consumer goods including 'Stainless kitchenware' and 'Aluminum kitchenware' recorded a year-on-year decrease.
- Capital goods including 'Bulk carriers' and 'Wafer processing equipment' recorded a year-on-year decrease.
- Intermediate goods including 'Hybrid integrated circuit' and 'System semiconductor' recorded a year-on-year increase.

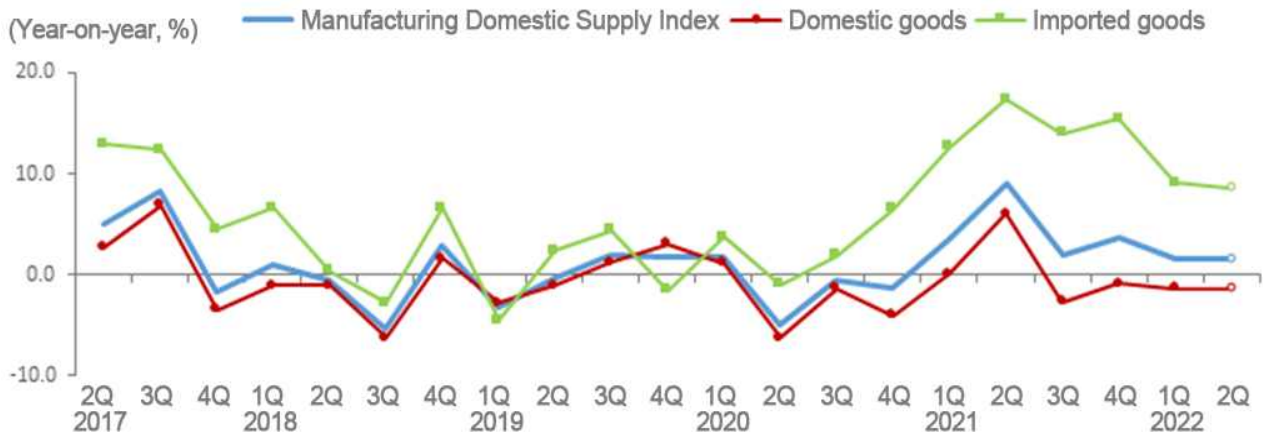
○ (By industry)

Compared to the second quarter of 2021, 'Fabricated metal products' declined by 9.4%. In the meantime, 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' and 'Pharmaceuticals, medicinal chemical and botanical products' grew by 15.5% and 17.1%, respectively.

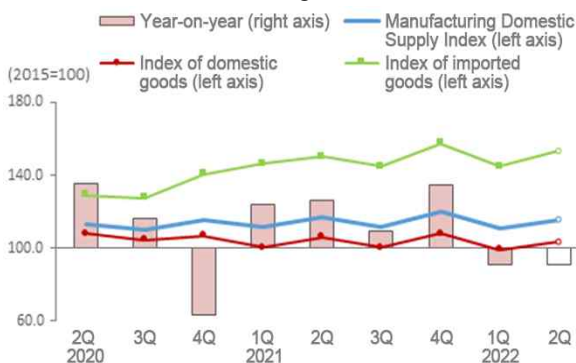

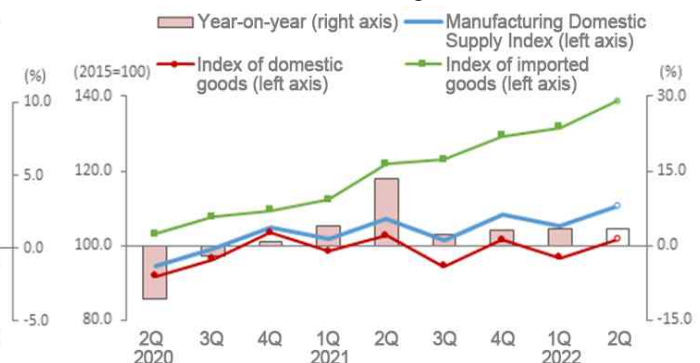


< Trends in the domestic supply of final goods >

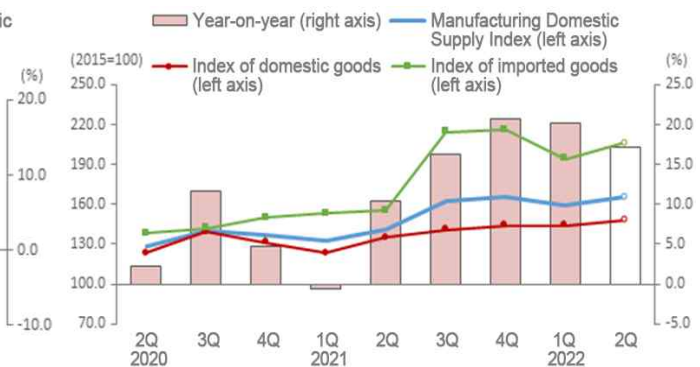
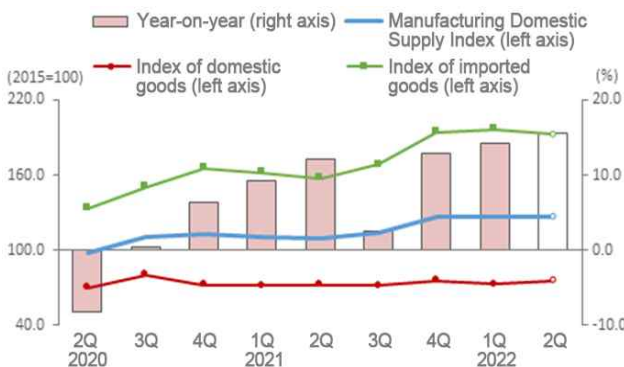
< Trends in the domestic supply of intermediate goods >

② (Share of imported goods)

In the second quarter of 2022, imported goods accounted for 30.7% of the total manufacturing domestic supply, up 2.0%p from the second quarter of 2021.

○ (Final goods)

Final goods took up 33.6% of the total imported goods, up 1.3%p from the second quarter of 2021.

- (Consumer goods)

Consumer goods occupied 30.8% of the total imported goods, up 2.5%p from the second quarter of 2021.

- (Capital goods)

Capital goods accounted for 37.8% of the total imported goods, remaining the same as the second quarter of 2021.

○ (Intermediate goods)

Intermediate goods took up 29.1% of the total imported goods, up 2.6%p from the second quarter of 2021.
