



Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index in the Third Quarter of 2022

1 (Domestic supply trend)

In the third quarter of 2022, the Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index rose by 5.3% from the third quarter of 2021, owing to the increase in domestic and imported goods.

○ (Domestic and imported goods)

Compared to the third quarter of 2021, the supply of domestic and imported goods grew by 2.1% and 13.0%, respectively.

○ (By type of goods)

Compared to the third quarter of 2021, final goods grew by 4.0%. (Among final goods, consumer goods and capital goods rose by 5.0% and 2.6%, respectively.) Intermediate goods grew by 6.3%.

- Consumer goods including 'Large passenger cars' and 'Mobile phones' recorded a year-on-year increase.
- Capital goods including 'Gas and chemical carriers' and 'Container ships' recorded a year-on-year increase.
- Intermediate goods including 'Motor vehicle parts' and 'Hybrid integrated circuit' recorded a year-on-year increase.

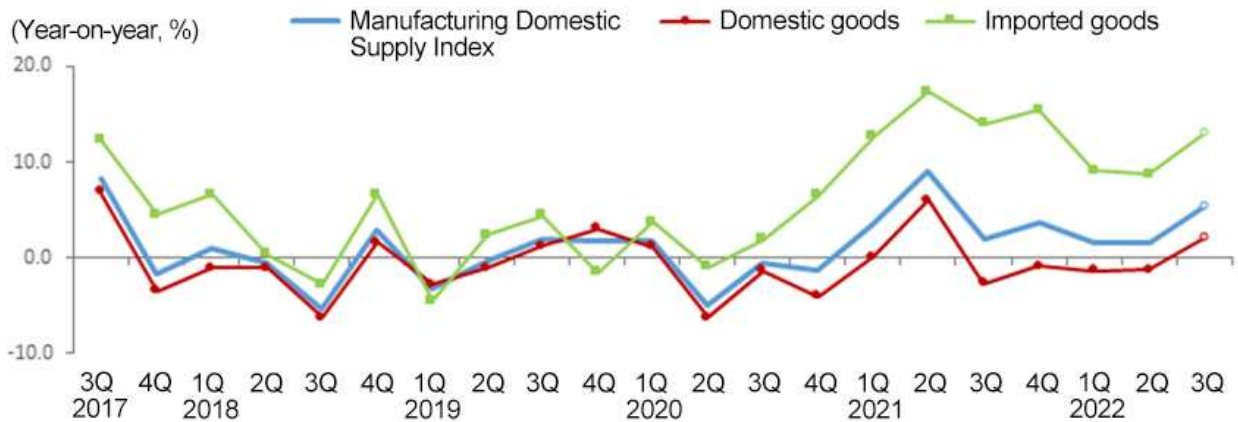
○ (By industry)

Compared to the third quarter of 2021, 'Basic metals' declined by 7.6%. In the meantime, 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' and 'Motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers' grew by 18.6% and 18.6%, respectively.

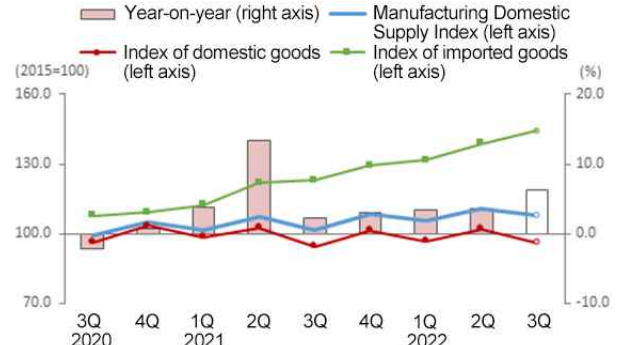
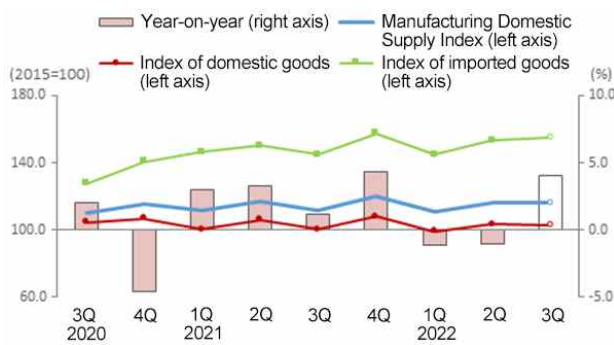

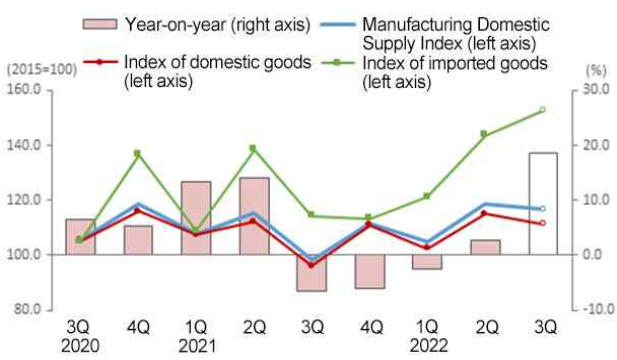
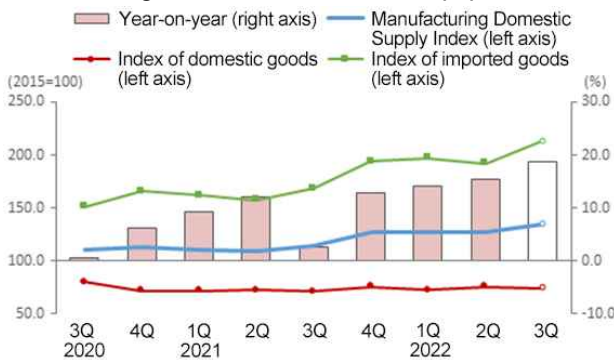
< Trends in the domestic supply of final goods >

2 (Share of imported goods)

In the third quarter of 2022, imported goods accounted for 32.2% of the total manufacturing domestic supply, up 2.0%p from the third quarter of 2021.

○ (Final goods)

Final goods took up 34.5% of the total imported goods, up 1.5%p from the third quarter of 2021.

- (Consumer goods)

Consumer goods occupied 31.8% of the total imported goods, up 2.6%p from the third quarter of 2021.

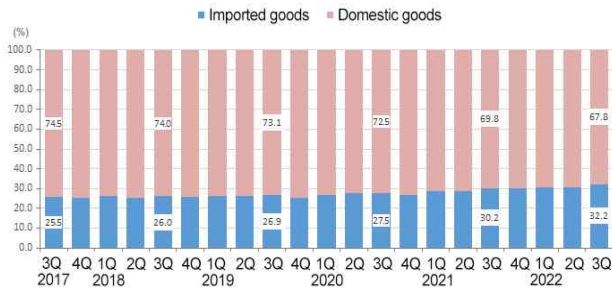
- (Capital goods)

Capital goods accounted for 38.7% of the total imported goods, remaining the same as the third quarter of 2021.

○ **(Intermediate goods)**

Intermediate goods took up 30.9% of the total imported goods, up 2.4%p from the third quarter of 2021.
