# Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index in the Fourth Quarter

# 1 (Domestic supply trend)

In the fourth quater of 2022, the Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index rose by 1.5% from the fourth quater of 2021, due to the increase in imported goods in spite of the decrease in domestic goods.

## O (Domestic and imported goods)

Compared to the fourth quarter of 2021, the supply of domestic goods fell by 0.6%, while that of imported goods grew by 6.2%.

## ○ (By type of goods)

Compared to the fourth quater of 2021, final goods rose by 0.6%. (Among final goods, consumer goods fell by 3.3%. Capital goods grew by 6.5%.) Intermediate goods grew by 2.1%.

- Consumer goods including 'Mobile phones' and 'Ready-made outer clothes' recorded a year-on-year decrease.
- Capital goods including 'Gas and chemical carriers' and 'Wafer processing equipment' recorded a year-on-year increase.
- Intermediate goods including 'Automotive parts' and 'System semiconductor' recorded a year-on-year increase.


#### ○ (By industry)

Compared to the fourth quater of 2021, 'Basic metals' declined by 11.5%. In the meantime, 'Motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers' and 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' grew by 18.4% and 9.0%, respectively.

# 2 (Share of imported goods)

In the fourth quater of 2022, imported goods accounted for 31.1% of the total manufacturing domestic supply, up 1.1%p from the fourth quater of 2021.

# O (Final goods)

Final goods took up 33.7% of, up 0.6%p from the fourth quater of 2021.


- (Consumer goods)
  Consumer goods occupied 33.0%, up 2.8%p from the fourth quater of 2021.
- (Capital goods)

  Capital goods accounted for 34.8%, down 2.8%p from the fourth quater of 2021.


# ○ (Intermediate goods)

Intermediate goods took up 29.5%, up 1.4%p from the fourth quater of 2021.

# Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index in 2022

## 1. Manufacturing domestic supply index

- ☐ In 2022, the Manufacturing Domestic Supply Index went up by 2.5% from 2021, due to the rise in imported goods despite the drop in domestic goods.
  - Compared to 2021, the supply of domestic goods fell by 0.4% owing to the drop in 'Chemicals and chemical products; except pharmaceuticals and medicinal chemicals' and 'Basic metals'. The supply of imported goods grew by 9.2% owing to the rise in 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' and 'Chemicals and chemical products; except pharmaceuticals and medicinal chemicals'.

# $\square$ (By type of goods)

Compared to 2021, final goods rose by 0.5%, owing to the increase in imported goods (2.2%) despite the decrease in domestic goods (-0.2%). Intermediate goods grew by 3.7%, owing to the increase in imported goods (14.6%) despite the decrease in domestic goods (-0.4%).

- Oconsumer goods grew by 0.5% from 2021, owing to the increase in imported goods (7.6%) despite the decrease in domestic goods (-2.2%).
- Capital goods rose by 0.5% from 2021, owing to the increase in domestic goods (3.1%) despite the decrease in imported goods (-3.7%).

## $\square$ (By industry)

Compared to 2021, 'Basic metals' showed a decrease in domestic supply. Whereas, 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' and 'Motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers' showed an increase in domestic supply.

O (Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment)
The supply of 'Electronic components, computer; visual, sounding and communication equipment' grew by 14.1% owing to the rise in domestic goods (1.9%) and imported goods (20.8%).

#### ○ (Motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers)

The supply of 'Motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers' grew by 9.1% owing to the rise in domestic goods (6.7%) and imported goods (23.7%).

## ○ (Basic metals)

The supply of 'Basic metals' fell by 4.7% owing to the drop in domestic goods (-5.1%) and imported goods (-3.4%).

## 2. Share of imported goods

☐ In 2022, imported goods accounted for 31.2% of the total manufacturing domestic supply, up 1.8%p from 2021.

#### ○ (By type of goods)

Final goods took up 33.9%, up 1.1%p from 2021. Intermediate goods took up 29.7%, up 2.4%p from 2021.

- Consumer goods occupied 31.5%, up 2.7%p from 2021. Capital goods accounted for 37.3%, down 1.2%p from 2021.

#### ○ (By industry)

Compared to 2021, 'Tobacco products', 'Wearing apparel, clothing accessories and fur articles' and 'Electrical equipment' recorded an increase in the share of imported goods. Whereas, 'Coke, briquettes and refined petroleum products' recorded a decrease in the share of imported goods.

- (Increase in the share of imported goods) 'Tobacco products' (7.3%p), 'Wearing apparel, clothing accessories and fur articles' (6.1%p), 'Electrical equipment' (4.8%p), etc.
- (Decrease in the share of imported goods)
  'Coke, briquettes and refined petroleum products' (-4.5%p), etc.
