

# Preliminary Results of the 2011 Agriculture & Fishery Corporation Survey

The number of agriculture and fishery corporations was 11,694 in 2011, which rose by 11.2 percent from 10,515 in 2010.

- The number of agriculture corporations grew by 11.6 percent to 10,871 in 2011. The number of fishery corporations grew by 6.2 percent to 823 in 2011. Agriculture and fishery corporations occupied 93.0 percent and 7.0 percent, respectively.

Corporations with '4 regular workers or less' occupied 66 percent of the total corporations.

- Corporations with '4 regular workers or less' accounted for 66 percent of the total corporations. Corporations with '4 regular workers or less' accounted for 66.5 percent of the total agriculture corporations. Corporations with '4 regular workers or less' accounted for 65.4 percent of the total fishery corporations.

- The number of workers was 6.9 persons per agriculture corporation. The number of workers was 6.5 persons per fishery corporation.

The aquaculture area per corporation dropped by 8.9 percent to 4.1ha in 2011.

- The aquaculture area totaled 1,519ha in 2011. The aquaculture area was 4.1ha per corporation. The decrease in aquaculture area per corporation was caused by the drop in aquaculture of shellfishes and seaweeds.

- The cumulative amount of government subsidies rose by 0.2 percent to 402.6 million won per agriculture corporation.
- The cumulative amount of government subsidies increased by 33.7 percent to 424.3 million won per fishery corporation.
