# Preliminary Results of 2011 Census on Establishments

#### Number of establishments and workers by year

- The number of establishments increased by 3.4 percent (114,027 establishments) to 3,469,497 establishments as of the end of 2011. The number of workers rose by 3.2 percent (564,166 persons) to 18,211,194 persons as of the end of 2011.
  - The number of establishments went up by 13.9 percent (423 thousand establishments) from 2001. The number of workers grew 29.1 percent (4,102 thousand workers) from 2001.

#### 2 Number of establishments and workers by industry

- As of the end of 2011, the number of establishments in 'Information and Communications' grew by 13.4 percent from the previous year, which showed the largest increase.
  - The number of establishments in 'Business Facilities Management and Business Support Services', 'Sewage, Waste Management, Materials Recovery and Remediation Activities' and 'Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities' grew by 12.3 percent, 8.9 percent and 8.3 percent, respectively.
  - The share of establishments in 'Information and Communications', 'Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities', 'Business Facilities Management and Business Support Services' and 'Human Health and Social Work Activities' increased by 0.1%p from the previous year, respectively. In the meantime, the share of establishments in 'Membership Organizations, Repair and Other Personal Services' dropped 0.1%p from 11.2 percent in 2010 to 11.1 percent in 2011. The share of establishments in 'Real Estate Activities and Renting & Leasing' fell 0.1%p from 3.8 percent in 2010 to 3.7 percent in 2011. The share of establishments in 'Transportation' declined 0.1%p from 10.3 percent in 2010 to 10.2 percent in 2011.

- The number of workers in 'Business Facilities Management and Business Support Services' grew 10.8 percent from the previous year, which recorded the largest increase.
- The number of workers in 'Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities', 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' increased by 7.8 percent, 6.1 percent and 5.2 percent from 2010, respectively. The number of workers in 'Construction', 'Mining and Quarrying' and 'Public Administration, Defence; Compulsory Social Security' decreased by 8.1 percent, 5.5 percent and 0.5 percent from 2010, respectively.

#### 3 Number of establishments and workers by size of workers

- The number of establishments with 100 to 299 workers went down by 1.1 percent (135 establishments) to 12,417 establishments as of the end of 2011. As for establishments with 100 to 299 workers, the number of workers fell by 1.5 percent (29,284 persons) from the previous year.
  - The number of establishments with 300 workers or more went up by 3.3 percent (107 establishments) to 3,398 establishments. As for establishments with 300 workers or more, the number of workers rose by 6.9 percent (176,311 persons) from the previous year.
  - The number of establishments with 1 to 4 workers grew by 2.6 percent. As for establishments with 1 to 4 workers, the number of workers rose by 2.6 percent. The number of establishments with 5 to 99 workers grew by 7.7 percent. As for establishments with 5 to 99 workers, the number of workers rose by 3.6 percent.
- As for establishments with 1 to 4 workers, the share of workers dropped by 0.2%p from the previous year. As for establishments with 100 to 299 workers, the share of workers dropped by 0.5%p from the previous year. In the meantime, as for establishments with 5 to 99 workers, the share of workers rose by 0.2%p from the previous year. As for establishments with 300 workers or more, the share of workers rose by 0.5%p from the previous year.

### Number of establishments by gender of the CEO

- The share of female CEOs showed an increase in all industries excluding 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities (a 0.5%p decrease)'. The share of female CEOs grew by 0.3%p from 37.2 percent in 2010 to 37.5 percent in 2011.
  - The share of female CEOs in 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities', 'Education' and 'Human Health and Social Work Activities' stood at 64.6 percent, 53.7 percent and 43.0 percent, respectively.

### 5 Number of workers by gender

- The number of female workers grew by 4.2 percent (303,307 persons) to 7,554,283 persons in 2011. The number of male workers rose by 2.5 percent (260,859 persons) to 10,656,911 persons in 2011.
- The share of male workers dropped by 0.4%p from 58.9 percent in 2010 to 58.5 percent in 2011. In the meantime, the share of female workers rose by 0.4%p from 41.1 percent in 2010 to 41.5 percent in 2011.

#### Number of workers by status of workers

○ The number of 'temporary and daily workers' and 'other unpaid workers' fell by 10.2 percent (257,121 persons) and 0.7 percent (6,219 persons) from the end of 2010, respectively.

- The number of regular workers and 'self-employed and unpaid family workers' grew by 7.2 percent (774,307 persons) and 1.5 percent (53,199 persons) from the end of 2010, respectively.
- As for workers by status of workers, the share of temporary and daily workers fell by 1.8%p from 14.3 percent in 2010 to 12.5 percent in 2011. The share of self-employed and unpaid family workers declined by 0.3%p from 20.1 percent in 2010 to 19.8 percent in 2011. The share of other unpaid workers dropped by 0.2%p from 4.9 percent in 2010 to 4.7 percent in 2011. In the meantime, the share of regular workers grew by 2.4%p from 60.6 percent in 2010 to 63.0 percent in 2011.

## Number of establishments and workers by type of legal organization

- The number of company corporations and non-company corporations increased by 8.9 percent (31,421 establishments) and 4.6 percent (4,262 establishments) from 2010, respectively. The number of individual establishments and non-corporate organizations went up by 2.8 percent (77,122 establishments) and 1.1 percent (1,222 establishments) from 2010, respectively.
- As for workers by type of legal organization, the number of workers in individual establishments and non-corporate organizations grew by 4.2 percent (290,350 persons) and 3.1 percent (13,061 persons) from 2010, respectively. The number of workers in non-company corporations and company corporations grew by 3.0 percent (80,409 persons) and 2.4 percent (180,346 persons) from 2010, respectively.
  - The share of workers in individual establishments went up by 0.4%p from 2010. In the meantime, the share of workers in company corporations went down by 0.4%p from 2010. The share of workers in corporations dropped from 58.5 percent in 2010 to 58.1 percent in 2011.
