# Preliminary Results of the 2011 Mining and Manufacturing Survey 

## 1. Number of establishments

The number of mining and manufacturing establishments with 10 workers or more totaled 63,442 in 2011, up 1.1 percent from the previous year.

## 2. Number of workers

The number of workers in mining and manufacturing was 2,712 thousand persons in 2011, up 2.4 percent from the previous year.

## 3. Value of shipment

The value of shipment in mining and manufacturing amounted to $1,501,698$ billion won in 2011, which increased by 13.0 percent from the previous year.

## 4. Value added

The value added of mining and manufacturing amounted to 487,524 billion won, rising 11.5 percent from the previous year.
