

Preliminary Results of Profit Corporation Statistics in 2013

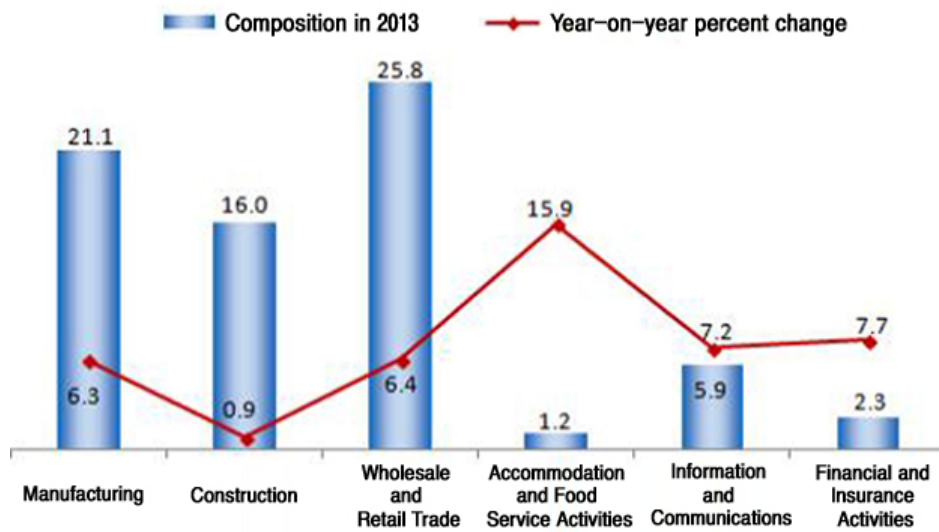
- The total number of enterprises was 506 thousand enterprises in 2013, which rose by 5.8 percent from 2012. The annual sales amounted to 4,131 trillion won, which grew by 1.0 percent from 2012. The assets amounted to 7,552 trillion won, which expanded by 4.2 percent from 2012.
- The annual sales per enterprise amounted to 8.2 billion won. The mean assets per enterprise amounted to 14.9 billion won.
- The number of large enterprises increased by 3.9 percent from 2012. The number of small and medium-sized enterprises increased by 5.8 percent from 2012.
- The annual sales of large enterprises fell by 0.3 percent, while those of small and medium-sized enterprises rose by 3.5 percent from 2012.
- The enterprises engaged in one kind of business occupied 83.1 percent of the total enterprises. The enterprises engaged in several kinds of business occupied 16.9 percent.
- The annual sales of enterprises engaged in one kind of business occupied 32.3 percent of the total annual sales. The annual sales of enterprises engaged in several kinds of business occupied 67.7 percent of the total annual sales.
- In 2013, the total enterprises were engaged in 1.2 types of activities on average. The large enterprises were engaged in 2.8 types of activities on average. The small and medium-sized enterprises were engaged in 2.7 types of activities on average.
- The average number of local units for the total enterprises was 1.3 units per enterprise. The average number of local units for the large enterprises was 14.1 units per enterprise. The average number of local units for the enterprise groups was 17.4 units per enterprise.

□ **Total enterprises**

○ **(Number of enterprises)**

The number of enterprises in 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' showed a high increase (15.9%) from 2012. Most industries including 'Information and Communications' (7.2%) recorded an increase.

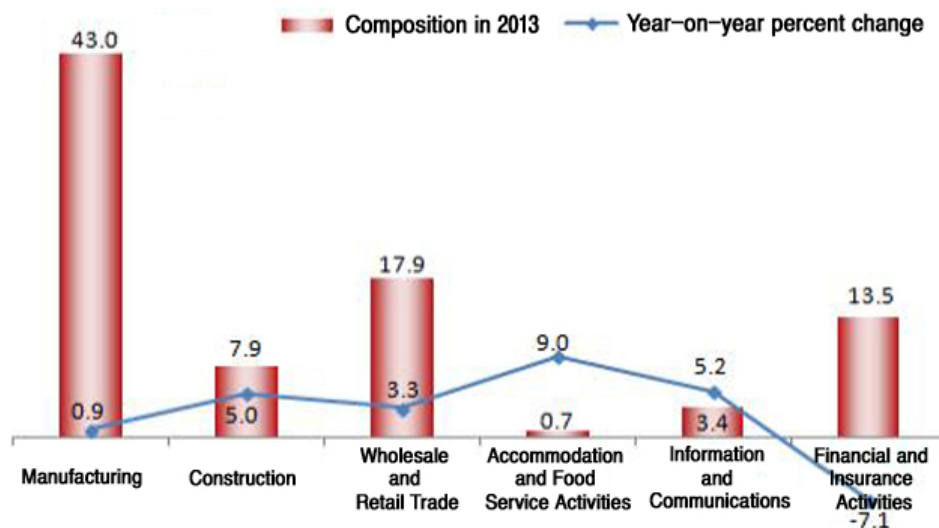
- As for the composition of enterprises by industry, 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' occupied the largest share of 25.8 percent. This share was followed by 'Manufacturing' (21.1%) and 'Construction' (16.0%).



○ **(Annual sales)**

The annual sales of 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' and 'Information and Communications' rose by 9.0 percent and 5.2 percent from 2012, respectively. Whereas, the annual sales of 'Financial and Insurance Activities' fell by 7.1 percent from 2012.

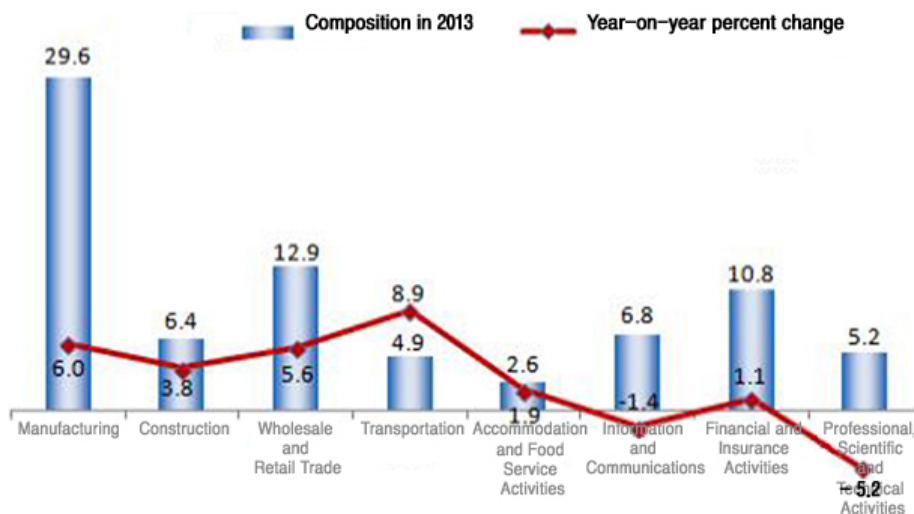
- The annual sales of 'Manufacturing' occupied the largest share (43.0%). This share was followed by 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' (17.9%) and 'Financial and Insurance Activities' (13.5%).



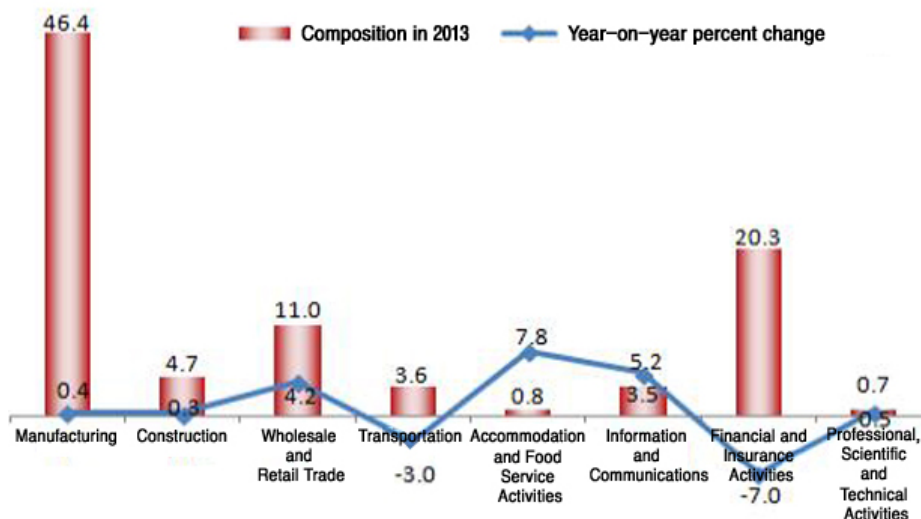
- According to the size of enterprises, enterprises are classified into 'Large enterprises' and 'Small and medium-sized enterprises'.

Large enterprises

- The number of enterprises in large enterprises was 4,223 in 2013, up 3.9 percent from 2012.
- The number of enterprises in 'Transportation' rose by 8.9 percent. Whereas, the number of enterprises in 'Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities' declined by 5.2 percent.
- ※ As for the composition of enterprises by industry, 'Manufacturing' occupied the largest share at 29.6 percent, which was followed by 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' (12.9%) and 'Financial and Insurance Activities' (10.8%).

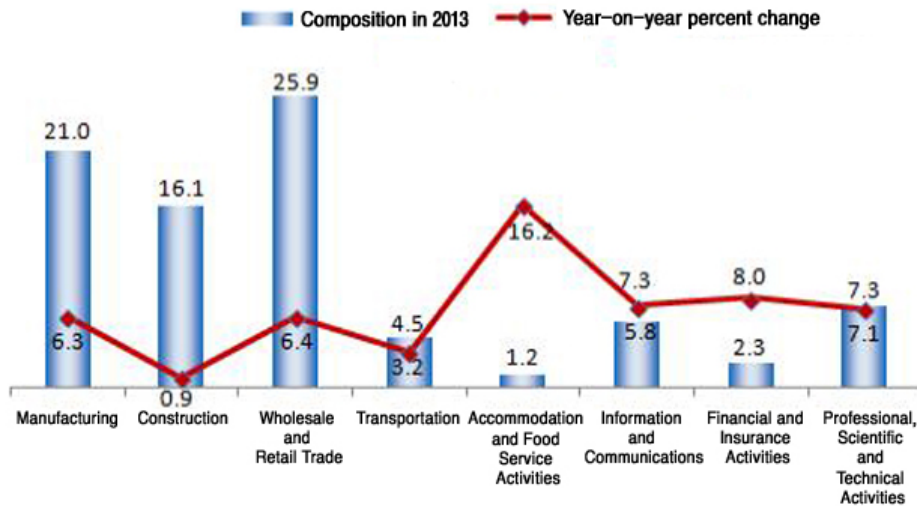


- The annual sales amounted to 2,659 trillion won in 2013, down 0.3 percent from 2012.
- The annual sales of 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' rose by 7.8 percent from 2012. In the meantime, the annual sales of 'Financial and Insurance Activities' dropped by 7.0 percent from 2012.
- ※ As for the composition of annual sales by industry, 'Manufacturing' occupied the largest share at 46.4 percent, which was followed by 'Financial and Insurance Activities' (20.3%) and 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' (11.0%).

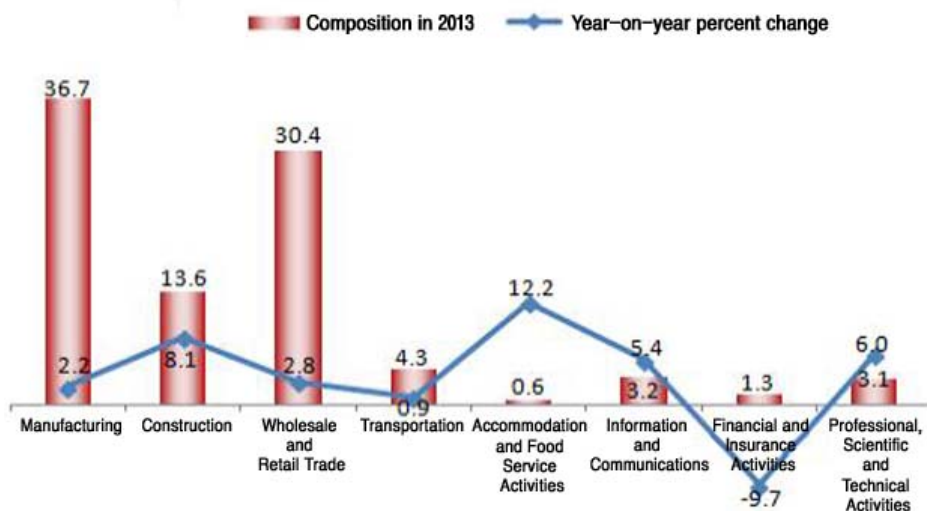


Small and medium-sized enterprises

- The number of enterprises in small and medium-sized enterprises was 502 thousand in 2013, up 5.8 percent from 2012.
- The number of enterprises in 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' and 'Financial and Insurance Activities' rose by 16.2 percent and 8.0 percent from 2012, respectively.



- ※ As for the composition of enterprises by industry, 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' occupied the largest share at 25.9 percent, which was followed by 'Manufacturing' (21.0%) and 'Construction' (16.1%).
- The annual sales amounted to 1,473 trillion won in 2013, up 3.5 percent from 2012.
- The annual sales of 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' rose by 12.2 percent from 2012. In the meantime, the annual sales of 'Financial and Insurance Activities' dropped by 9.7 percent from 2012.
- ※ As for the composition of annual sales by industry, 'Manufacturing' occupied the largest share at 36.7 percent, which was followed by 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' (30.4%) and 'Construction' (13.6%).



Enterprise groups (with assets of 5 trillion won or more) according to the classification of the Fair Trade Commission

- The number of enterprises in enterprise groups fell by 1.8 percent from 2012.
 - As for the number of enterprises in enterprise groups by industry, 'Transportation' rose by 14.7 percent. In the meantime, most industries including 'Construction'(6.7%) and 'Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities' (6.7%) showed a decrease.
 - As for the composition of enterprises in enterprise groups by industry, 'Manufacturing' occupied the largest share (22.8%). This share was followed by 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' (11.4%) and 'Information and Communications' (11.3%).
- The annual sales of enterprise groups declined by 0.4 percent from 2012.
 - As for annual sales of enterprise groups by industry, 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' grew by 9.1 percent from 2012. In the meantime, 'Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities' and 'Construction' fell by 5.9 percent and 3.0 percent, respectively.
 - As for the composition of annual sales by industry, 'Manufacturing' occupied the largest share (52.7%). This share was followed by 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' (10.7%) and 'Financial and Insurance Activities' (9.7%).
 - The average annual sales per enterprise recorded 1,027.4 billion won in 2013. As for the average annual sales per enterprise by industry, 'Manufacturing' marked the highest figure of 2,376.5 billion won, which was followed by 'Financial and Insurance Activities' (1,240.8 billion won).

According to the type of enterprises, enterprises are classified into 'Enterprises engaged in one kind of business' and 'Enterprises engaged in several kinds of business'.

Enterprises engaged in one kind of business

○ **(Number of enterprises)**

The number of enterprises engaged in one kind of business grew by 6.6 percent year-on-year.

- Most industries including 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' (18.2 percent) and 'Information and Communications' (8.3 percent) showed a year-on-year increase.

○ **(Annual sales)**

The annual sales of enterprises engaged in one kind of business rose by 3.3 percent year-on-year.

- 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' and 'Construction' rose by 20.0 percent and 10.2 percent from 2012, respectively. Whereas, 'Financial and Insurance Activities' fell by 13.7 percent from 2012.

Enterprises engaged in several kinds of business

○ (Number of enterprises)

The number of enterprises engaged in several kinds of business grew by 2.0 percent year-on-year.

- Most industries including 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' (11.5 percent) showed a year-on-year increase.

○ (Annual sales)

The annual sales of enterprises engaged in several kinds of business remained the same year-on-year.

- 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' and 'Information and Communications' rose by 7.4 percent and 3.9 percent from 2012, respectively. Whereas, 'Transportation' fell by 4.4 percent from 2012.

□ Type of activities according to sub-classes of industrial classification

- As for the type of activities by industry, the enterprises in 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' were engaged in 1.5 types of activities on average. The enterprises in 'Manufacturing' were engaged in 1.3 types of activities on average. The enterprises in 'Wholesale and Retail Trade' were engaged in 1.2 types of activities on average.
