## Economically Active Population Survey in September 2022

## < Economically active population and labor force participation rate >

The economically active population marked 29.093 million persons in September, which grew 654 thousand persons or $2.3 \%$ year-on-year.

The labor force participation rate stood at $64.2 \%$ in September, up 1.2\%p year-on-year.
< Employed persons and employment to population ratio >

The number of employed persons totaled 28.389 million persons in September, which went up 707 thousand persons or $2.6 \%$ year-on-year.

The employment to population ratio recorded $62.7 \%$ in September, up $1.4 \%$ p year-on-year.
< Unemployed persons and unemployment rate >

The number of unemployed persons totaled 704 thousand people in September, which decreased 52 thousand persons or $6.9 \%$ year-on-year.

The unemployment rate marked $2.4 \%$ in September, down 0.3\%p year-on-year.
< Economically inactive population >

The economically inactive population totaled 16.191 million people in September, decreasing 495 thousand persons or $3.0 \%$ year-on-year.
