Economically Active Population Survey in October 2022

< Economically active population and labor force participation rate >

- The economically active population marked 29.110 million persons in October, which grew 582 thousand persons or 2.0% year-on-year.
- The labor force participation rate stood at 64.3% in October, up 1.1%p year-on-year.
- < Employed persons and employment to population ratio >
- The number of employed persons totaled 28.418 million persons in October, which went up 677 thousand persons or 2.4% year-on-year.
- The employment to population ratio recorded 62.7% in October, up 1.3%p year-on-year.
- < Unemployed persons and unemployment rate >
- The number of unemployed persons totaled 692 thousand people in October, which decreased 95 thousand persons or 12.1% year-on-year.
- The unemployment rate marked 2.4% in October, down 0.4%p year-on-year.

< Economically inactive population >

O The economically inactive population totaled 16.192 million people in October, decreasing 428 thousand persons or 2.6% year-on-year.
