<Economically active population and labor force participation rate>

- The economically active population marked 29.618 million persons in June, which grew 252 thousand persons or 0.9% year-on-year.
- The labor force participation rate stood at 65.3% in June, up 0.4%p year-on-year.

<Employed persons and employment to population ratio>

- The number of employed persons totaled 28.812 million persons in June, which went up 333 thousand persons or 1.2% year-on-year.
- The employment to population ratio recorded 63.5% in June, up 0.6%p year-on-year.

<Unemployed persons and unemployment rate>

- The number of unemployed persons totaled 807 thousand people in June, which decreased 81 thousand persons or 9.1% year-on-year.
- The unemployment rate marked 2.7% in June, down 0.3%p year-on-year.

<Economically inactive population>

• The economically inactive population totaled 15.765 million people in June, decreasing 118 thousand persons or 0.7% year-on-year.
