Economically Active Population Survey in June 2024

<Economically active population and labor force participation rate>

- The economically active population marked 29.764 million persons in June, which grew 146 thousand persons or 0.5% year-on-year.
- The labor force participation rate stood at 65.3% in June, remaining the same year-on-year.

<Employed persons and employment to population ratio>

- The number of employed persons totaled 28.907 million persons in June, which went up 96 thousand persons or 0.3% year-on-year.
- The employment to population ratio recorded 63.5% in June, remaining the same year-on-year.

<Unemployed persons and unemployment rate>

- The number of unemployed persons totaled 857 thousand people in June, which increased 50 thousand persons or 6.2% year-on-year.
- The unemployment rate marked 2.9% in June, up 0.2%p year-on-year.

<Economically inactive population>

- The economically inactive population totaled 15.786 million people in June, increasing 21 thousand persons or 0.1% year-on-year.
