Employment of double-earner households

Double-earner households

- O In October 2022, married couple households amounted to 12.691 million households. Among them, double-earner households marked 5.846 million households in October 2022, which rose by 20 thousand households from October 2021.
 - Compared to October 2021, the share of double-earner households went up by 0.2%p to 46.1% of the married couple households in October 2022.
- O As for the share of double-earner households by age of household head, heads aged '50~59' and '40~49' showed a high figure of 55.2%, respectively. All age groups showed a year-on-year increase in double-earner households.

☐ Households of double-earner couples living together

- O Households of double-earner couples engaged in the same industry accounted for 35.6% in October 2022, down 1.1%p from October 2021.
 - As for the share of households of double-earner couples engaged in the same industry, 'Agriculture, forestry and fisheries' showed the highest figure at 82.1%, which was followed by 'Wholesale and retail trade & Accommodation and food service activities' (51.2%).
- O Households of double-earner couples engaged in the same occupation took up 37.6% in October 2022, down 0.6%p from October 2021.
- As for the share of households of double-earner couples with the same occupation, 'Skilled agricultural, forestry and fishery workers' showed the highest figure at 81.7%, which was followed by 'Professionals and related workers' (51.0%).

□ Double-earner households with children aged 17 or less

- O Married couple households with children aged 17 or less totaled 4.069 million households. Among them, double-earner households amounted to 2.168 million households, which fell by 79 thousand households.
 - The share of double-earner households with children aged 17 or less stood at 53.3% in October 2022, remaining the same year-on-year.
- O Compared to October 2021, as for the share of double-earner households by age of the youngest child, the double-earner households with children 'aged 13~17' went down by 0.9%p. Whereas, the double-earner households with children 'aged 7~12' and 'aged 6 or less' rose by 0.3%p and 0.2%p, respectively.
- O The average weekly working hours of double-earner households with children aged 17 or less stood at 37.0 hours in October 2022, which dropped by 1.1 hours from October 2021.

Employment of one-person households

□ One-person households whose member was employed

- O In October 2022, the number of one-person households was 7.224 million households, rising by 184 thousand households year-on-year.
- O One-person households whose member was employed totaled 4.555 million households in October 2022, rising by 204 thousand households from October 2021.
 - Among the total one-person households, those whose member was employed occupied 63.1%, up 1.3%p year-on-year.


☐ Status of one-person households whose member was employed.

- O As for the share of one-person households whose member was employed by gender, males (70.6%) recorded a higher share than females (55.5%). The share of one-person female households whose member was employed (1.5%p) showed a higher year-on-year increase than that of male counterparts (1.0%p).
- O As for the share of one-person households whose member was employed by age group, people aged 30~39 recorded the highest figure of 88.0%, which was followed by those aged 40~49 (82.4%).
- O As for the share of one-person households whose member was employed by industry, 'Manufacturing' occupied the largest share at 15.0%, which was followed by 'Wholesale and retail trade' (10.6%).
- O As for the share of one-person households whose member was employed by occupation, 'Professionals and related workers' occupied the largest share at 23.9%, which was followed by 'Clerks' (16.5%).
- O The average weekly working hours of one-person households whose member was employed stood at 37.0 hours in October 2022, which dropped by 0.8 hours from October 2021.


☐ Wage workers by wage level

- O As for the share of wage workers by wage level, workers earning '2 million won ~ less than 3 million won' occupied the largest share at 35.3%, which was followed by workers earning '3 million won ~ less than 4 million won' (23.7%).
 - Compared to October 2021, the share of wage workers earning '1 million won ~ less than 2 million won' declined by 3.7%p. Whereas, the share of wage workers earning '4 million won or more' rose by 3.3%p.
