



Supplementary Results of the Economically Active Population Survey for the Economically Inactive Population in August 2023

□ In August 2023, the economically inactive population was 16.163 million persons, which declined by 83 thousand persons from August 2022. The economically inactive population occupied 35.6% of the population aged 15 or more, falling by 0.3%p from August 2022.





* Survey reference period: Every August

O As for the economically inactive population by gender, females occupied 63.1% of the total economically inactive population, which was higher than males (36.9%). As for the economically inactive population by age group, people aged 70 or more occupied the largest share at 26.1%, which was followed by those aged 60~69 (18.6%) and those aged 20~29 (13.4%).




- ☐ The economically inactive population who wanted to get a job or establish a business within 1 year was 3.418 million persons, which accounted for 21.1% of the economically inactive population. This percentage went down by 0.5%p compared to August 2022.
 - O As for the intention to get a job or establish a business by age group, people aged 20~29 showed the largest share at 45.0%, which was followed by those aged 30~39 (43.7%), those aged 40~49 (33.2%) and those aged 50~59 (29.3%).

< Share of the economically inactive population with an intention to get a job or establish a business by age group (%) >




- ☐ Characteristics of the economically inactive population who wanted to get a job or establish a business within 1 year
 - O As for the reasons for getting a job or establishing a business, the largest share (72.6%) wanted to earn living expenses or pocket money.

- O As for the employment type to be desired, 93.4% of the economically inactive population wanted to get a job as a wage worker. In the meantime, 6.6% of the economically inactive population wanted to get a job as a non-wage worker.
 - As for the detailed employment type to be desired, 'Full-time job' occupied the largest share at 67.8%, which was followed by 'Part-time job' (25.7%), 'Self-employed person' (6.1%) and 'Unpaid family worker' (0.4%).
 - As for the reasons for getting a part-time job, 'Due to health' occupied the largest share at 36.9%, which was followed by 'Child care and child education' (20.4%) and 'To carry out other things or activities side by side' (17.5%).

- O As for the first priority to be considered when getting a job, the largest share (31.5%) of the economically inactive population who wanted to get a job as a wage worker considered 'Working conditions'. As for the first priority to be considered when establishing a business, the largest share (52.0%) of the economically inactive population considered revenue and profit.
 - As for the monthly average wages to be desired when getting a job, '2 million ~ less than 3 million won' occupied the largest share at 44.5%.
 - As for the reasons for establishing a business, 'To utilize time freely' occupied the largest share at 29.6%.

	78.9% of the economically inactive population had no intention to get a job or establish a business. This percentage rose by 0.5%p compared to August 2022.
0	As for the reasons for not getting a job or establishing a business by gender, the largest share of males (34.9%) mentioned 'Commuting to (or attending) school or preparation for a higher education'. Whereas, the largest share of females (39.1%) mentioned 'House work'.
