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# Household Income and Expenditure Trends in the Third Quarter of 2024

#### ☐ (Income) The average monthly household income per household amounted to 5.255 million won in the third guarter of 2024, which grew by 4.4% from the third guarter of 2023. O The employee income marked 3.329 million won, rising by 3.3% year-on-year. The self-employment income marked 987 thousand won, rising by 0.3% year-on-year. The transfer income marked 784 thousand won, rising by 7.7% year-on-year. ☐ (Expenditure) The average monthly household expenditure amounted to 3.975 million won in the third quarter of 2024, which grew by 2.7% from the third quarter of 2023. O The average monthly consumption expenditure per household marked 2.907 million won, which rose by 3.5% year-on-year. The average monthly non-consumption expenditure per household marked 1.068 million won, which rose by 0.5% year-on-year. - The expenditures on 'Housing, water, electricity and other fuels' (12.6%), 'Restaurants and hotels' (5.6%), 'Other miscellaneous goods and services' (9.0%) and 'Health' (7.9%) showed a year-on-year increase. Whereas, the expenditures on 'Transportation' (-4.3%), 'Communication' (-3.6%) and 'Education' (-1.3%) showed a year-on-year decrease. # ☐ (Disposable income and surplus)

The average monthly disposable income per household was 4.188 million won in the third quarter of 2024, going up by 5.5% from the third quarter of 2023. The surplus amounted to 1.28 million won, going up by 10.2% from the third quarter of 2023.

O The average propensity to consume stood at 69.4%, down 1.3%p from the third quarter of 2023.

#### 1. Income

- ☐ The average monthly household income amounted to 5.255 million won in the third quarter of 2024, which grew by 4.4% from the third quarter of 2023. (At 2020 prices, an increase of 2.3% from the third quarter of 2023)
- O The current income grew by 3.7% to 5.154 million won.
  - The employee income marked 3.329 million won, rising by 3.3% year-on-year. The self-employment income marked 987 thousand won, rising by 0.3% year-on-year. The transfer income marked 784 thousand won, rising by 7.7% year-on-year.
    - \* A 6.0% increase of public transfer income and an 11.3% increase of private transfer income.
- O The non-current income grew by 63.9% to 102 thousand won.

## 2. Consumption Expenditure

- ☐ The average monthly consumption expenditure per household marked 2.907 million won in the third quarter of 2024, which rose by 3.5% from the third quarter of 2023. (At 2020 prices, an increase of 1.4% from the third quarter of 2023)
  - O The expenditures on 'Housing, water, electricity and other fuels', 'Restaurants and hotels', 'Other miscellaneous goods and services', 'Health' and 'Recreation and culture' rose by 12.6%, 5.6%, 9.0%, 7.9% and 6.9%, respectively.
  - O The expenditures on 'Transportation', 'Communication', 'Education' and 'Clothing and footwear' fell by 4.3%, 3.6%, 1.3% and 1.6%, respectively.

### 3. Non-consumption Expenditure

- □ The average monthly non-consumption expenditure per household totaled 1.068 million won in the third quarter of 2024, which grew by 0.5% from the third quarter of 2023.
- O The regular tax, the transfer to non-profit institutions and the pension contribution grew by 5.9%, 11.0% and 2.4%, respectively, from the third quarter of 2023. Whereas, the interest and the transfer between households fell by 9.9% and 2.1%, respectively, from the third quarter of 2023.

# 4. Disposable Income and Surplus

- ☐ The average monthly disposable income per household was 4.188 million won in the third quarter of 2024, which went up by 5.5% from the third quarter of 2023.
  - O The surplus amounted to 1.28 million won, which rose by 10.2% from the third quarter of 2023.
  - O The surplus rate stood at 30.6%, up 1.3%p from the third quarter of 2023.
  - O The average propensity to consume stood at 69.4%, down 1.3%p from the third quarter of 2023.

### 5. Income and Expenditure by Income Quintile

- □ In the third quarter of 2024, the average monthly income of the lowest quintile amounted to 1.182 million won, which grew by 5.4% from the third quarter of 2023. The average monthly income of the highest quintile amounted to 11.543 million won, which rose by 6.5% from the third quarter of 2023.
  - O The disposable income of the lowest quintile totaled 962 thousand won, which grew by 6.1% from the third quarter of 2023.
    - The average propensity to consume of the lowest quintile stood at 134.7%, down 1.6%p from the third quarter of 2023.
- O The disposable income of the highest quintile totaled 8.981 million won, which grew by 8.0% from the third quarter of 2023.
  - The average propensity to consume of the highest quintile stood at 56.2%, down 3.0%p from the third quarter of 2023.

- □ In the third quarter of 2024, the average monthly consumption expenditure of the lowest quintile amounted to 1.296 million won, which grew by 4.8% from the third quarter of 2023. The average monthly consumption expenditure of the highest quintile amounted to 5.045 million won, which rose by 2.5% from the third quarter of 2023.
  - O As for the consumption expenditure of the lowest quintile, 'Food and non-alcoholic beverages' occupied the largest share at 22.6%, which was followed by 'Housing, water, electricity and other fuels' (18.1%) and 'Restaurants and hotels' (13.4%).
  - O As for the consumption expenditure of the highest quintile, 'Restaurants and hotels' occupied the largest share at 16.2%, which was followed by 'Food and non-alcoholic beverages' (12.4%) and 'Education' (11.9%).
