According to administrative data (officially announced house price data, building register, etc.), the total number of houses was 15,301 thousand units. Among them, houses that individuals owned (excluding houses that corporations owned) amounted to 12,721 thousand units. Individual house owners totaled 11,958 thousand persons.

Owners of 1 house or less (including co-ownership) accounted for 89.3 percent of the total house owners. Owners of more than 1 house to 2 houses accounted for 9.1 percent of the total house owners. Owners of 2 houses or less accounted for 98.4 percent of the total house owners.

Male and female apartment owners occupied 56.8 percent and 43.2 percent, respectively. The share of male apartment owners was 13.6%p higher than that of female apartment owners.

\bigcirc (By age group)

Apartment owners in their forties occupied the largest share (31.4 percent) of the total apartment owners. This share was followed by those in their fifties (26.3 percent) and those in their thirties (20.0 percent). The mean age of apartment owners was 49.3 years.

- As for those in their thirties, forties and fifties, the percentage of apartment owners was higher than that of house owners. In the meantime, as for those in their sixties, seventies and eighties, the percentage of apartment owners was lower than that of house owners.
