



# Internal Migration in October 2022

- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 456 thousand persons in October 2022, which fell by 15.5% year-on-year.
- ☐ In October 2022, the internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 10.5%, which declined by 1.9%p year-on-year.

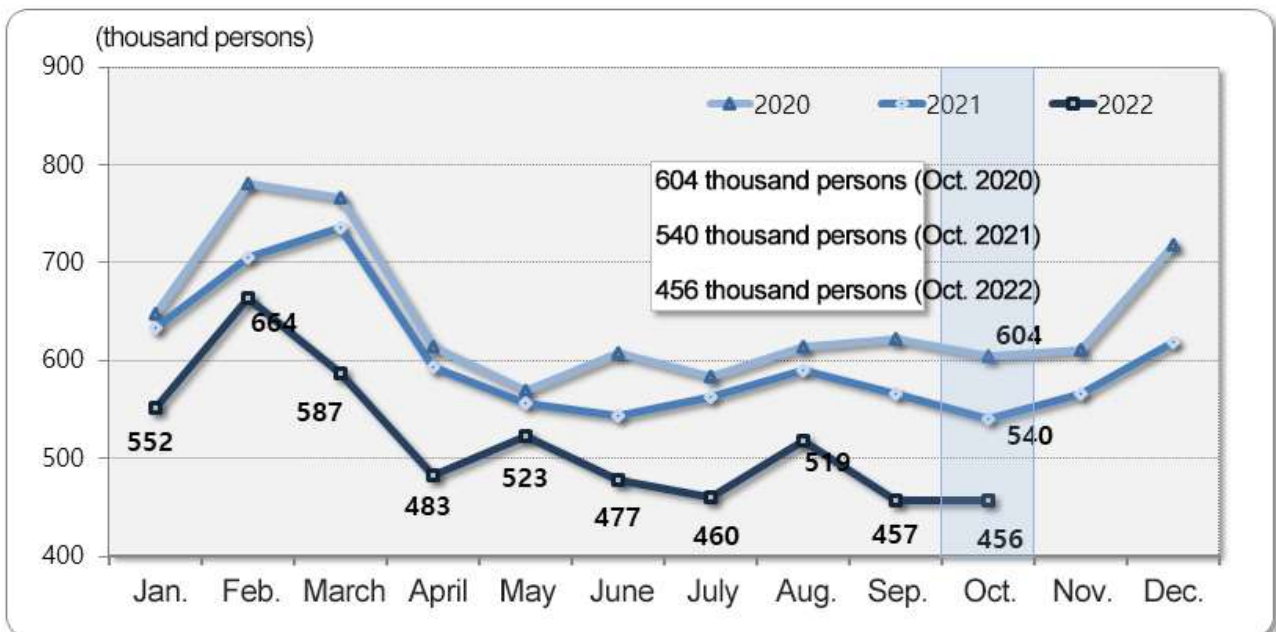

## 1. Internal migration

- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 456 thousand persons in October 2022, falling by 15.5% (83 thousand persons) year-on-year.
- ☐ The intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants accounted for 67.3% and 32.7% of the total internal migrants in October 2022, respectively.
- Compared to October 2021, the intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants fell by 15.7% and 14.9%, respectively.

- The internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 10.5%, down 1.9%p year-on-year.

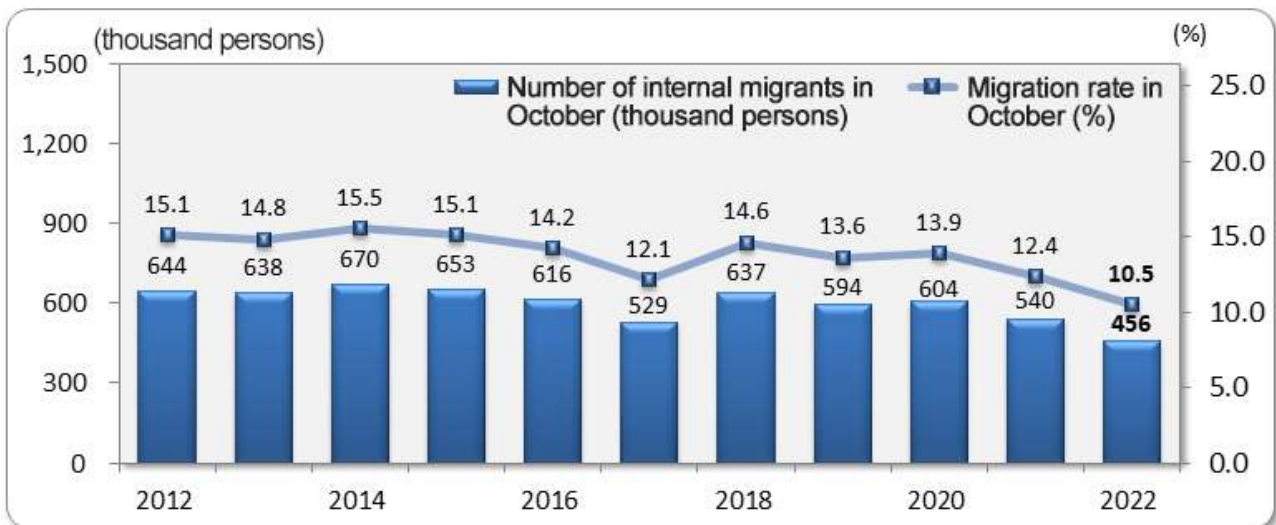

## 2. Internal migration for metropolitan cities and provinces

- Regarding the net migration of metropolitan cities and provinces, 8 regions recorded a plus net migration.: Gyeonggi (4,619 persons), Incheon (2,506 persons), Chungnam (1,756 persons), etc. On the other hand, 9 regions recorded a minus net migration.: Seoul (-6,436 persons), Gyeongnam (-1,130 persons), Busan (-818 persons) and so on.
- Incheon, Chungnam and Sejong recorded a plus net migration rate of 1.0%, 1.0% and 0.6%, respectively. On the other hand, Seoul, Ulsan and Gyeongnam recorded a minus net migration rate of -0.8%, -0.5% and -0.4%, respectively.
