Internal Migration in November 2023


- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 496 thousand persons in November 2023, which grew by 4.3% year-on-year.
- ☐ In November 2023, the internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 11.8%, which went up by 0.5%p year-on-year.

1. Internal migration

- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 496 thousand persons in November 2023, rising by 4.3% (20 thousand persons) year-on-year.
- ☐ The intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants occupied 67.9% and 32.1% of the total internal migrants in November 2023, respectively.
 - O Compared to November 2022, the intra-province migrants grew by 6.9%, while the inter-province migrants fell by 1.0%.


☐ The internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 11.8%, up 0.5%p year-on-year.

2. Internal migration for metropolitan cities and provinces

- Regarding the net migration of metropolitan cities and provinces, 7 regions recorded a plus net migration.: Incheon (3,901 persons), Gyeonggi (2,922 persons), Chungnam (1,909 persons), etc. On the other hand, 10 regions recorded a minus net migration.: Seoul (-6,239 persons), Busan (-1,153 persons), Gwangju (-517 persons) and so on.
- □ Incheon, Chungnam and Chungbuk recorded a plus net migration rate of 1.6%, 1.1% and 0.3%, respectively. On the other hand, Seoul, Gwangju and Busan recorded a minus net migration rate of -0.8%, -0.4% and -0.4%, respectively.
