| | In the first quarter of 2021, the Mining and Manufacturing Production Index showed a year-on-year increase in 13 regions including Gyeonggi (11.2%) and Chungbuk (8.7%). Whereas, the Mining and Manufacturing Production Index showed a year-on-year decrease in 4 regions including Busan (-7.1%) and Gyeongnam (-4.2%). [The nation: 4.5%] |

| | Exports (based on customs clearance) showed a year-on-year increase in 16 regions such as Gangwon (34.7%) and Chungbuk (24.0%). Whereas, exports showed a year-on-year decrease in Incheon (-1.0%). [The nation: 12.5%] |
| | The employment-population ratio marked a year-on-year increase in 3 regions such as Jeonbuk (1.2%p) and Daegu (1.0%p). Whereas, the employment-population ratio marked a year-on-year decrease in 14 regions including Gangwon (-1.8%p) and Gyeongnam (-1.7%p). [The nation: -1.3%p] |
| | The Consumer Price Index marked a year-on-year increase in all 16 regions such as Jeonnam (1.5%) and Gyeongnam (1.4%). [The nation: 1.1%] |




Production

- ☐ (Mining and Manufacturing Production Index)
 In the first quarter of 2021, the Mining and Manufacturing Production Index of the nation rose by 4.5% year-on-year due to the increase in 'Semiconductor', 'Motor Vehicles and Trailers' and 'Machinery and Equipment'.
- O The Mining and Manufacturing Production Index recorded a year-on-year decrease in Busan (-7.1%), Gyeongnam (-4.2%) and Gangwon (-3.9%) due to a drop in 'Machinery and Equipment', 'Other Transport Equipment' and 'Medicines'. In the meantime, the Mining and Manufacturing Production Index recorded a year-on-year increase in Gyeonggi (11.2%) and Chungbuk (8.7%) due to a rise in 'Semiconductor & Electronic Components' and 'Chemical Products'.
 - < Mining and Manufacturing Production Index in the first quater of 2021 >




- ☐ (Index of Services)
 - In the first quarter of 2021, the Index of Services for the nation went up by 2.2% year-on-year due to the increase in 'Financial and Insurance Activities' and 'Wholesale and Retail Trade'.
 - O The Index of Services showed a year-on-year decrease in Jeju (-6.4%), Incheon (-4.9%) and Gangwon (-1.0%) owing to the drop in 'Information and Communications', 'Transportation and Storage' and 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities'. Whereas, the Index of Services showed a year-on-year increase in Seoul (6.3%), Daegu (2.6%) and Gyeonggi (1.8%) due to the rise in 'Financial and Insurance Activities' and 'Wholesale and Retail Trade'.






Consumption and Construction


- ☐ (Retail Sales Index)
 - In the first quarter of 2021, the Retail Sales Index of the nation went up by 6.3% year-on-year due to a rise in 'Retail Sales not in Stores' and 'Passenger Cars and Fuel Stores'.
 - O The Retail Sales Index marked a year-on-year decrease in Jeju (-8.1%) and Incheon (-2.6%) owing to a drop in 'Duty-free Shops' and 'Supermarkets, Convenient Stores and Other Retail Sale in Non-specialized Stores'. On the other hand, the Retail Sales Index marked a year-on-year increase in Daegu (9.5%), Daejeon (8.3%) and Gwangju (5.1%) due to a rise in 'Passenger Cars and Fuel Stores' and 'Specialized Stores'.





- ☐ (Construction orders received)
 In the first quarter of 2021, the construction orders received of the nation rose 25.0% year-on-year due to the increase in 'Factories and storage', 'Dwellings'. and 'Others'.
 - O As for construction orders received, Ulsan (-63.3%), Gwangju (-49.9%) and Jeonbuk (-40.1%) recorded a year-on-year drop owing to a decrease in 'Dwellings' and 'Roads and bridges'. Meanwhile, Jeju (168.5%), Gyeongbuk (135.6%) and Chungnam (103.4%) recorded a year-on-year rise owing to an increase in 'Generation of electricity and communication' and 'Dwellings'






Exports

- ☐ (Exports)
 - In the first quarter of 2021, the exports for the nation grew by 12.5% year-on-year due to a rise in 'Passenger cars', 'Memory semiconductor' and 'Vessels'.
- O Exports recorded a year-on-year decrease in Incheon (-1.0%) due to a drop in 'Medicines', 'Vessels' and 'Other transport equipment'. In the meantime, exports recorded a year-on-year increase in Gangwon (34.7%), Chungbuk (24.0%) and Jeonnam (22.3%) owing to a rise in 'Other electric and electronic products', 'Medicines' and 'Steel plate'.



Employment


- ☐ (Employment-population ratio)
 - In the first quarter of 2021, the employment-population ratio of the nation stood at 58.6%, down 1.3%p year-on-year due to the decrease in the employment-population ratio of the groups aged '30 ~ 39'. '20 ~ 29' and '40 ~ 49'.
- O The employment-population ratio showed a rise in Jeonbuk (1.2%p), Daegu (1.0%p) and Sejong (0.1%p). In the meantime, the employment-population ratio showed a drop in Gangwon (-1.8%p), Gyeongnam (-1.7%p) and Gyeongbuk (-1.7%p).

Consumer Price Index

- \square (Consumer Price Index)
 - In the first quarter of 2021, the Consumer Price Index of the nation went up by 1.1% year-on-year owing to a rise in 'Agricultural products' and 'Personal services'.
 - O Compared to the nation, Jeonnam (1.5%), Gyeongnam (1.4%) and Chungbuk (1.3%) recorded a higher year-on-year increase rate owing to the rise in 'Agricultural products'. Whereas, Seoul (0.8%), Gyeongbuk (0.9%) and Gangwon (1.0%) recorded a lower year-on-year increase rate owing to the drop in 'Public services' and 'Petroleum products'.






Population

☐ (Internal net migration)

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- In the first quarter of 2021, 5 regions such as Gyeonggi (57,092 persons), Sejong (4,306 persons) and Jeju (695 persons) recorded a plus net migration.
- On the other hand, 12 regions including Seoul (-26,071 persons), Daegu (-7,518 persons) and Ulsan (-5,460 persons) recorded a minus net migration.
