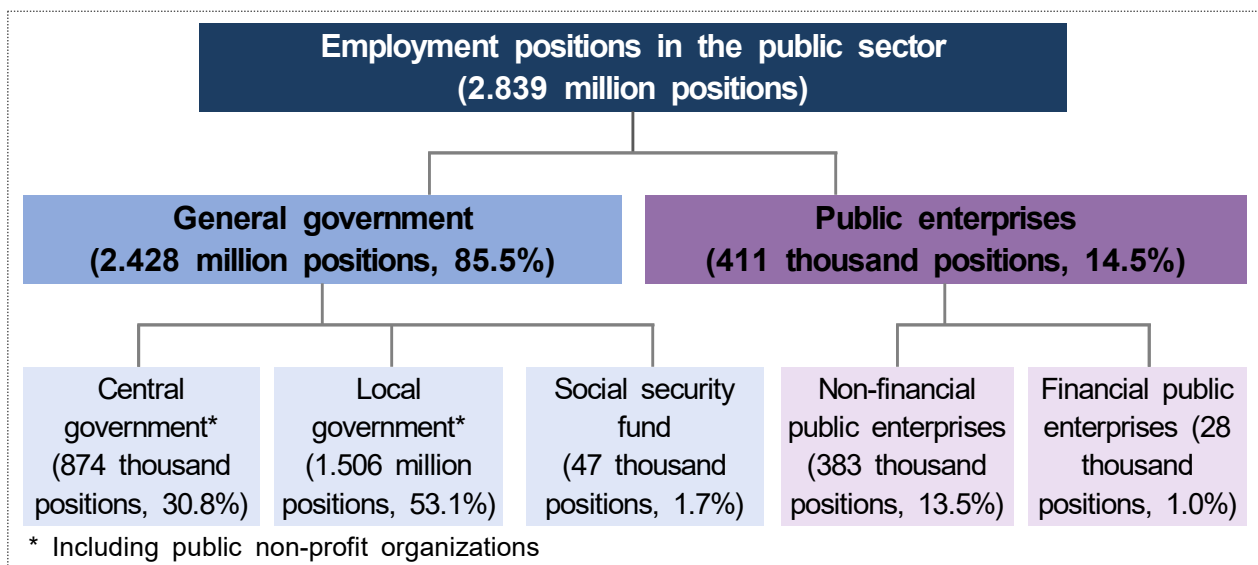




2021 Employment Position Statistics in the Public Sector

1. Overview of employment positions in the public sector

- In 2021, employment positions in the public sector marked 2.839 million positions, which rose by 73 thousand positions (2.6%) from 2020.
- The employment positions of general government recorded 2.428 million positions (85.5%). Employment positions in public enterprises recorded 411 thousand positions (14.5%).
- Compared to the previous year, the employment positions of general government rose by 53 thousand positions (2.2%). Employment positions in public enterprises grew by 20 thousand (5.2%).



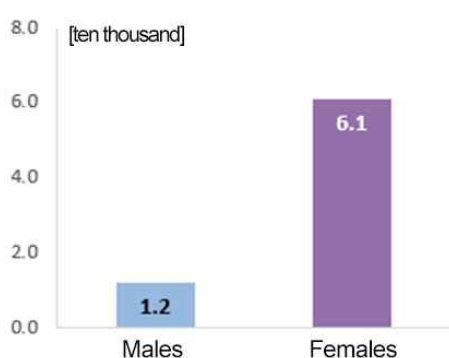
- Employment positions in the public sector occupied 10.3% of the total employed persons, rising by 0.1%p from 2020.
- ※ Employment positions in the public sector occupied 11.1% of the total employment positions, dropping by 0.1%p from 2020.

2. Employment positions in the public sector by characteristics of workers

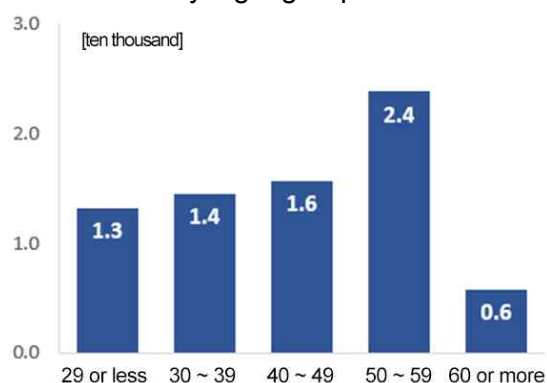
- The employment positions in the public sector of males stood at 1.486 million positions in 2021, which was 1.10 times higher than those of females (1.353 million positions).

- Compared to 2020, the employment positions of males and females rose by 12 thousand positions and 61 thousand positions, respectively.
- As for employment positions by age group, workers aged 40 ~ 49 recorded the highest figure of 758 thousand positions, which was followed by those aged 30 ~ 39 (697 thousand positions) and those aged 50 ~ 59 (676 thousand positions).
- Compared to 2020, all age groups showed an increase in employment positions. In particular, the employment positions of workers aged '50 ~ 59', '40 ~ 49' and '30 ~ 39' increased by 24 thousand positions, 16 thousand positions and 14 thousand positions, respectively.

< Change in employment positions by gender >



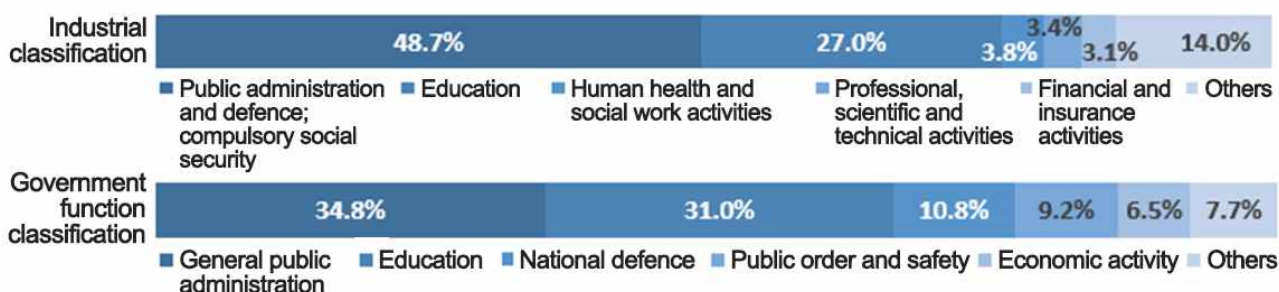
< Change in employment positions by age group >



3. Employment positions in the public sector by characteristics of enterprises

- As for employment positions in the public sector by industry, 'Public administration and defence; compulsory social security' recorded the highest figure of 1.383 million positions, which was followed by 'Education' (765 thousand positions).
- Compared to 2020, 'Education' showed the highest increase of 30 thousand positions.
- As for employment positions by general government function, 'General public administration' recorded the highest figure of 844 thousand positions. This figure was followed by 'Education' (753 thousand positions), 'National defence' (262 thousand positions) and 'Public order and safety' (224 thousand positions).

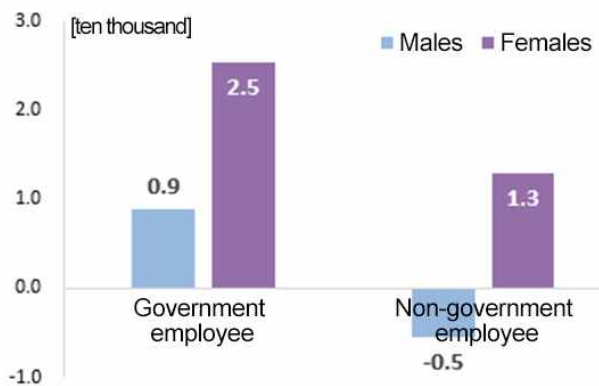
< Employment positions in the public sector by industry and general government function >



4. Employment positions in government agencies

- Employment positions in government agencies stood at 2.168 million positions in 2021, which grew by 42 thousand positions (2.0%) from 2020.
- Government employee positions were 1.9 times higher than non-government employee positions. Compared to 2020, government and non-government employee positions rose by 34 thousand positions (2.5%) and 7 thousand positions (1.0%), respectively.
- As for employment positions by gender, the government employee positions of males and females grew by 9 thousand positions and 25 thousand positions, respectively. On the other hand, the non-government employee positions of females rose by 13 thousand positions. Whereas, the non-government employee positions of males declined by 5 thousand positions.
- The government employee positions recorded a year-on-year increase in all age groups. On the other hand, the non-government employees aged '40 ~ 49' and '50 ~ 59' recorded a year-on-year increase. Whereas, the non-government employees aged '39 or less' and '60 or more' recorded a year-on-year decrease.
